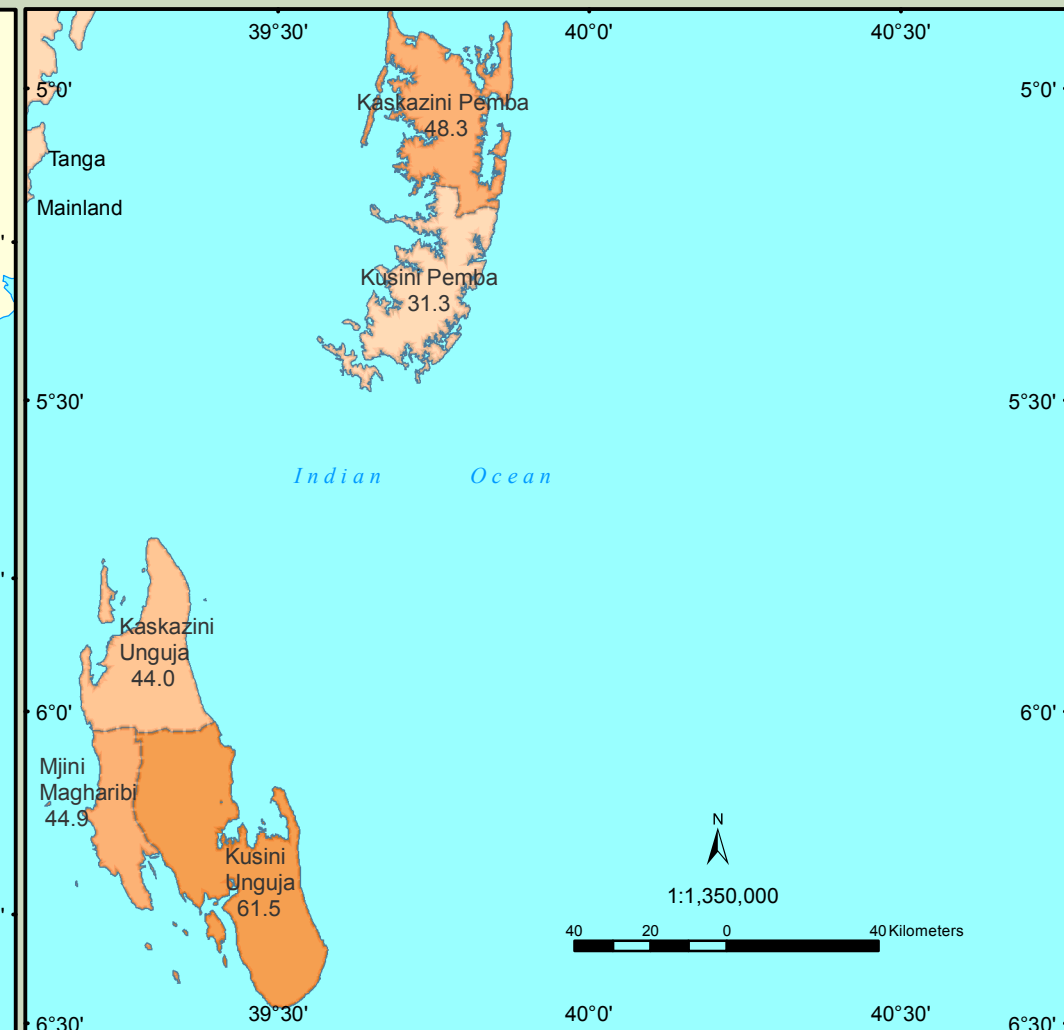
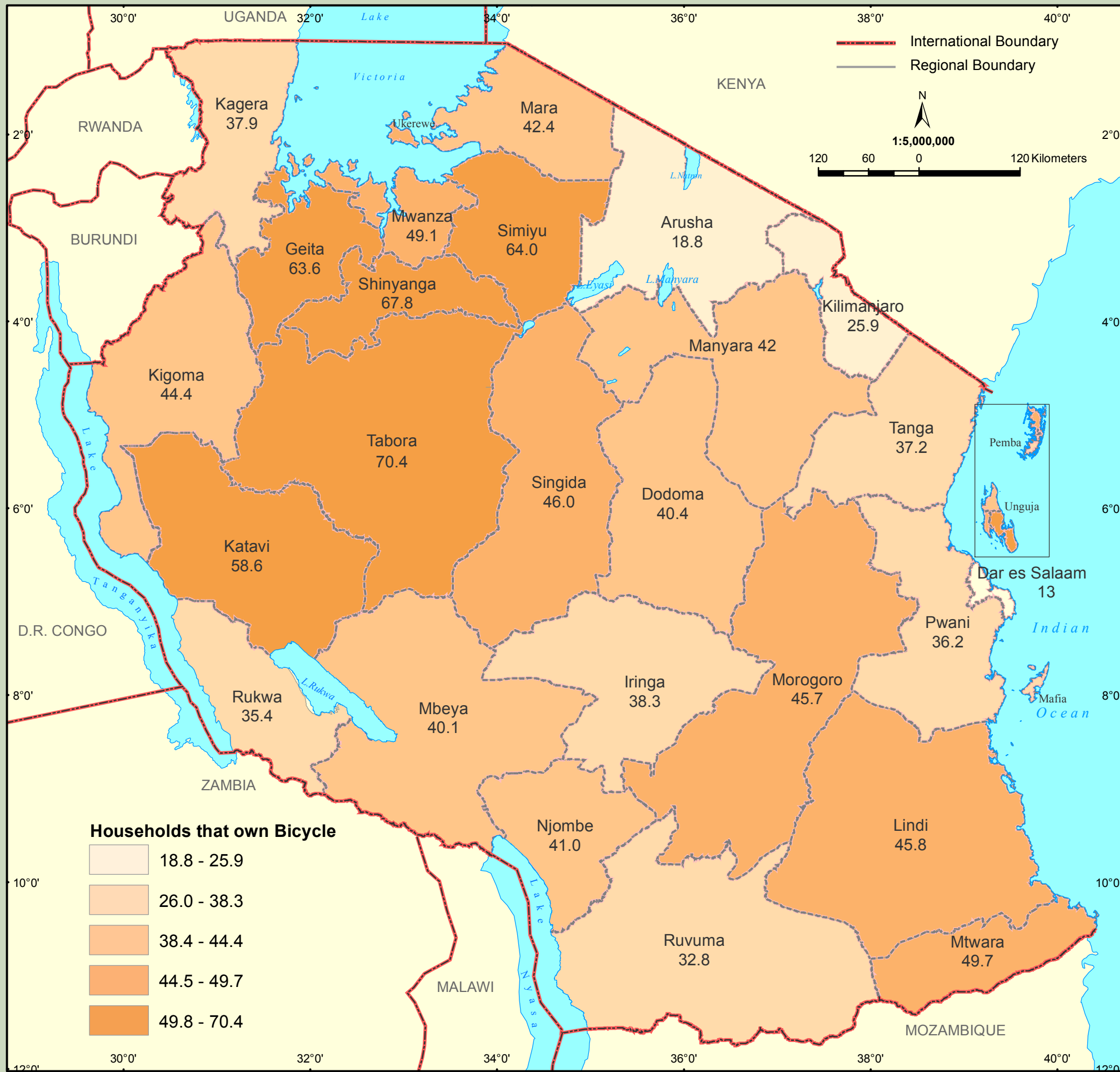


Proportion of private households that own bicycle



Distribution of bicycles in Tanzania is well spread in geographically low and flat land and mostly in rural areas. Overall, 39.9 percent of all private households own bicycles. Referring to the situation in the regions, Tabora has the highest proportion of private households which own bicycles (70.4 percent) followed by Shinyanga (67.8), Simiyu (64.0), Geita (63.6), Kusini Unguja (61.5) and Katavi (58.6). On the other hand, regions which had the lowest proportion of households that were owning bicycles are Dar es Salaam (13.0), Arusha (18.8) and Kilimanjaro (25.9). While not many households owned bicycles in Dar es Salaam due to the prevailing big number of vehicles on the roads, the terrain found in Arusha and Kilimanjaro does not allow households to ride bicycles in such conditions that exist.
