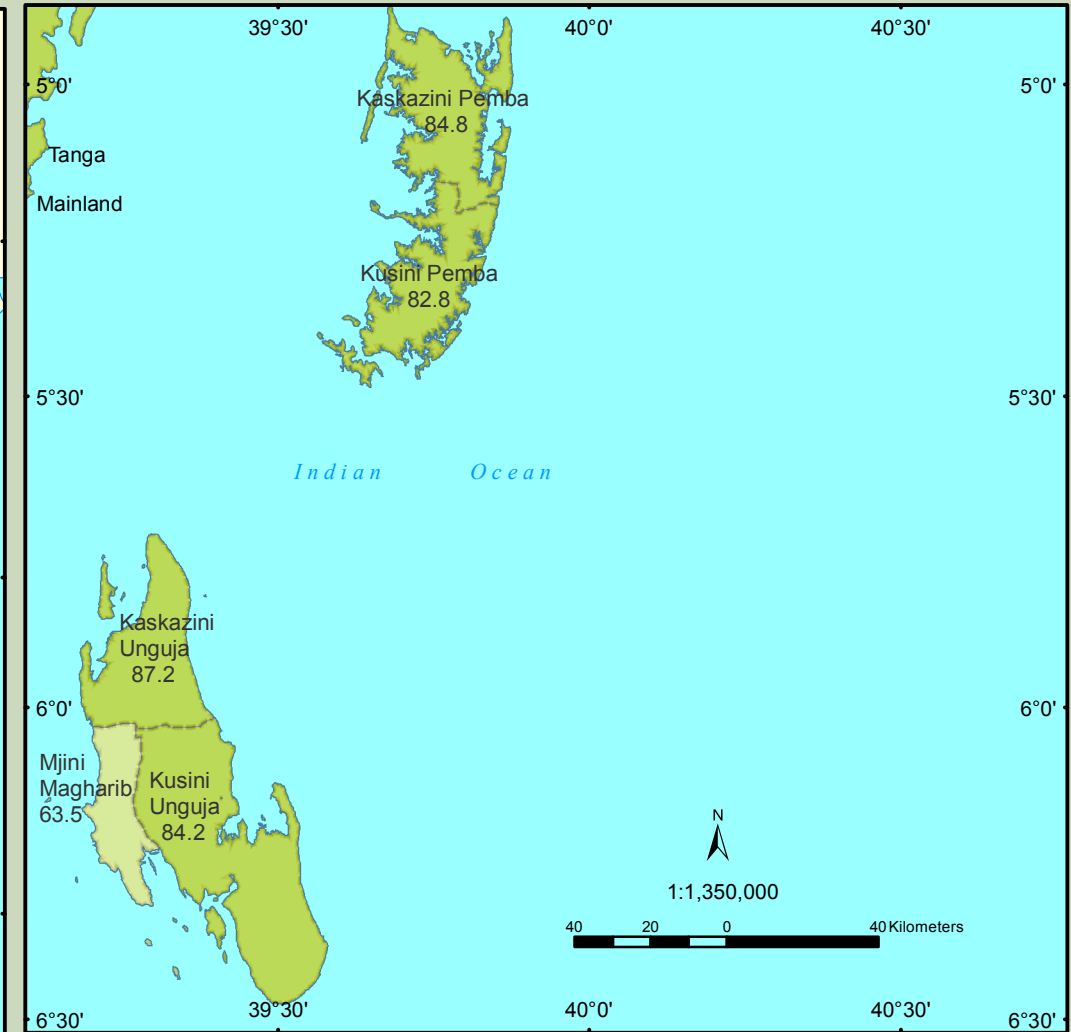
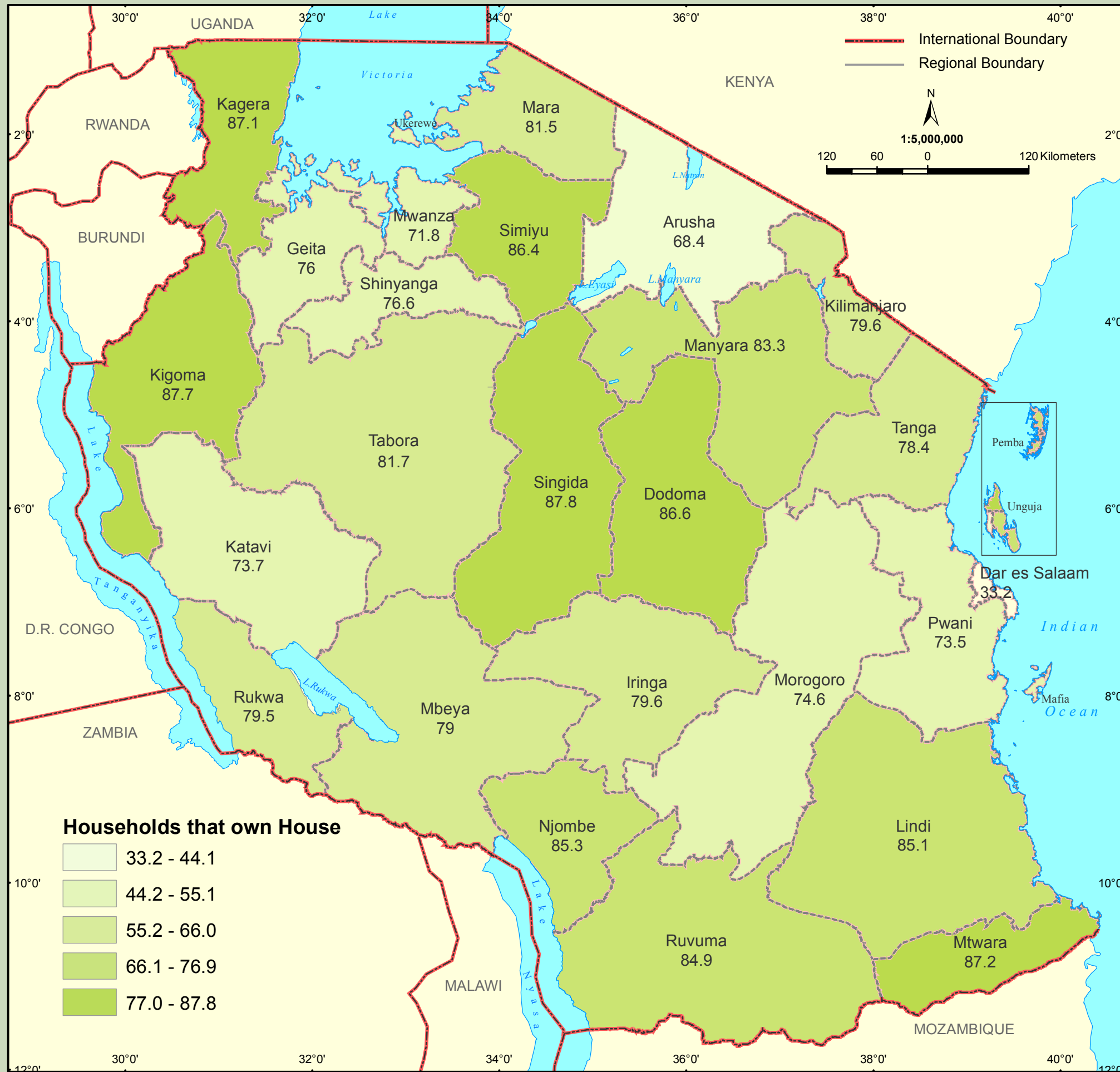


# Proportion of private households that own house



Overall, 74.8 percent of all private households in Tanzania own houses in which they are staying. At the regional level, as the map shows, As expected, urban regions of Mjini Magharibi and Dar es Salaam recorded the lowest proportions of households that were owning houses (30.2 and 33.2 percent respectively). Most regions had more than 70 percent of households which owned houses. Regions which had lower than 70 percent of households included Arusha (68.3), Kaskazini Unguja (66.3) and Kusini Unguja (64.0). On the other hand, regions which had the highest proportions of households that owned houses are Simiyu (88.5), Singida (87.8), Mtwara (87.2), Kagera (87.0) and Dodoma (86.6).
