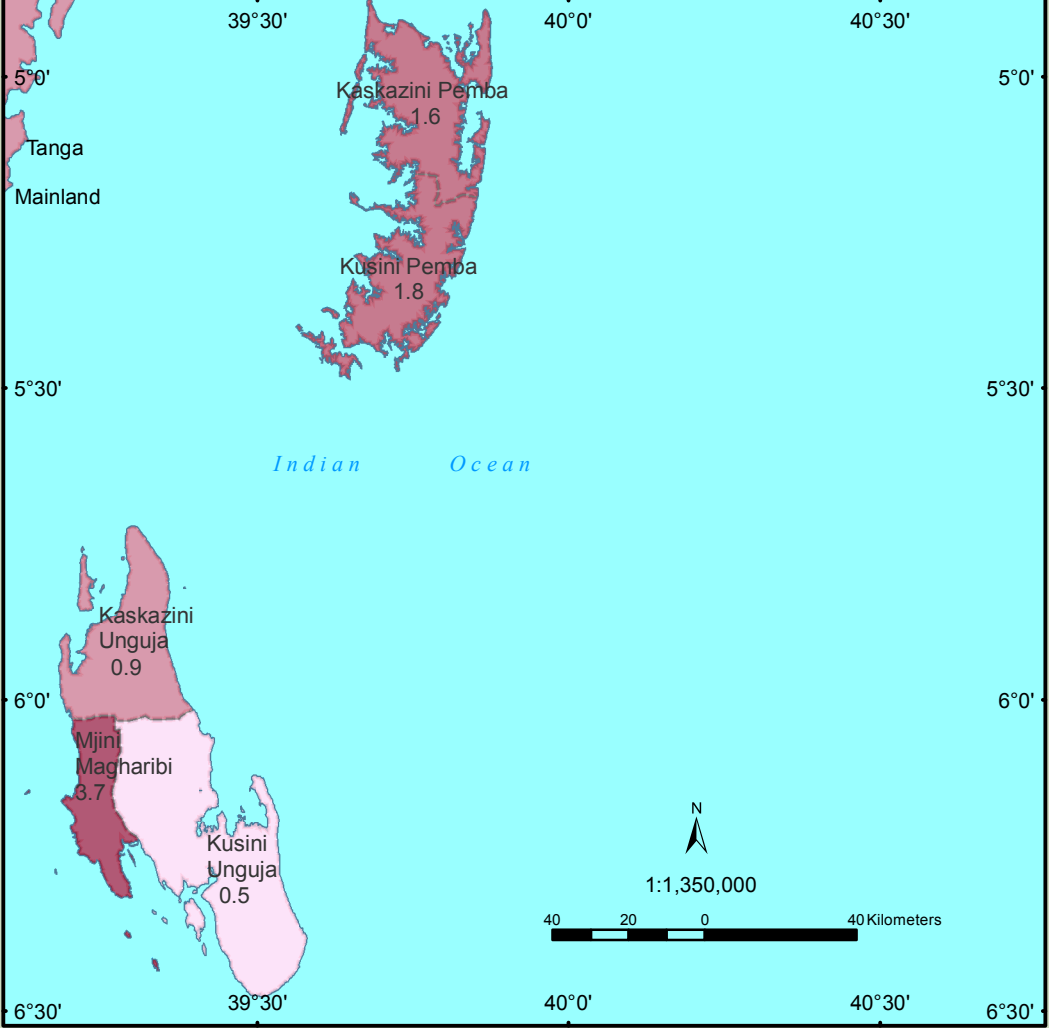
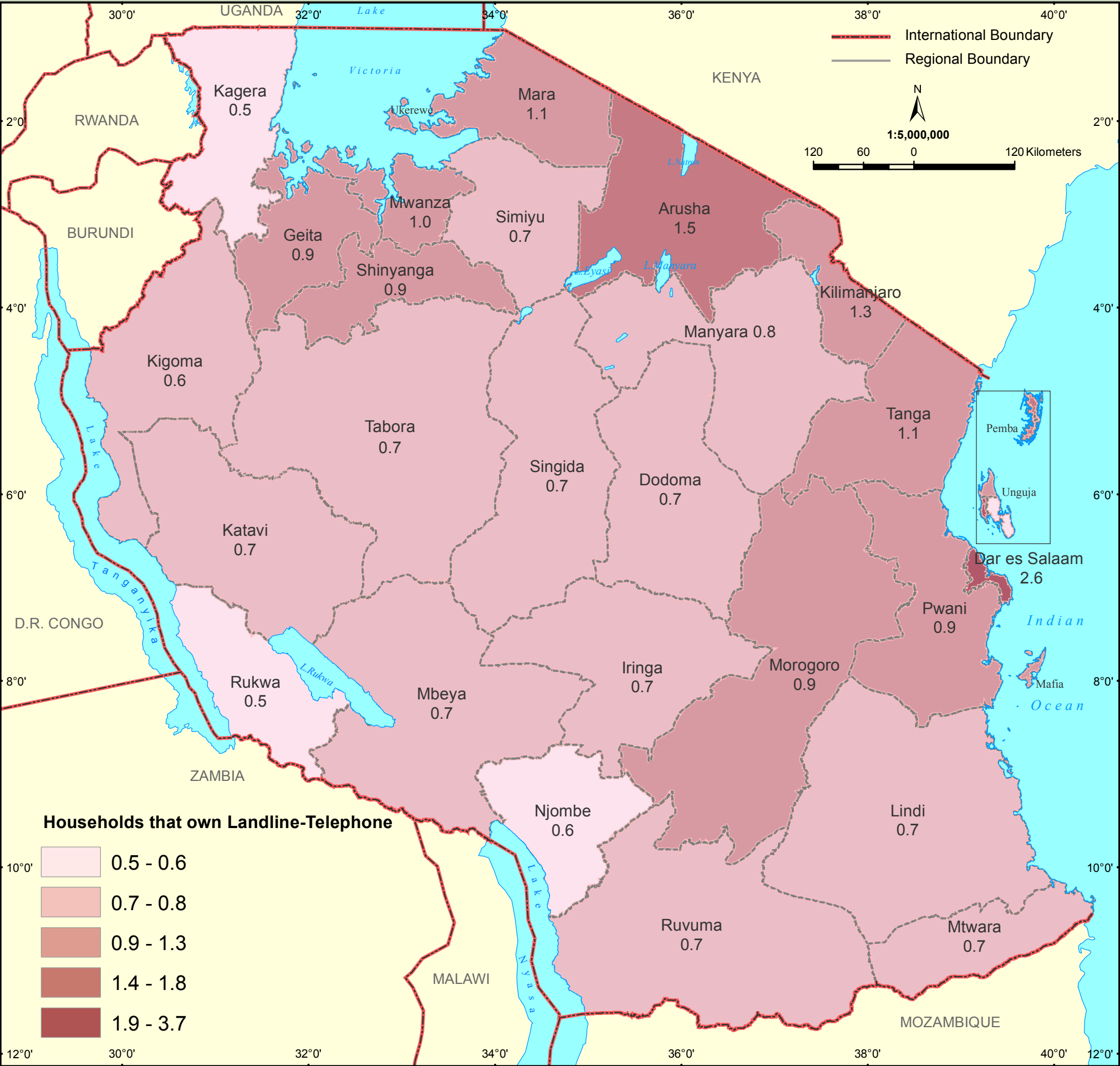


Proportion of private households that own landline-telephone



Ownership of landline telephones is not popular any more. About one percent only of all private households in Tanzania owned landline telephones (1.1). Majority of the regions had less than one percent of households that owned landline telephones . However, Mjini Magharibi recorded the highest proportion of households that owned landline telephones (3.7) followed by Dar es Salaam (2.6), Kusini Pemba (1.8), Kaskazini Pemba (1.6), Arusha (1.5), Kilimanjaro (1.3) Tanga and Mara (1.1 each) and Mwanza (1.0).
