The use of mobile phones appears to be popular among most households as 63.9 of all households in the country have cellular (mobile) phones. Regions which recorded more than three quarters of households with mobile phones were Mjini Magharibi (91.3), Dar es Salaam (89.7), Kusini Unguja (82.0), Kilimanjaro (79.1) and Arusha (75.4). On the other side, Rukwa had the lowest proportion of households which owned mobile telephones. Other regions with low proportions of households (lower than 50 percent) with such phones were Mtwara (41.8), Lindi (43.2), Kigoma (48.4) and Dodoma (49.6).
