



Tanzania population density



Overall, the population of Tanzania is sparsely distributed (51 persons per square kilometer). However, there are areas with concentration of people particularly in urban areas. Dar es Salaam Region and Mjini Magharibi, predominantly urban, have population densities of 3,133 and 2,581 persons per square kilometer, respectively. Lindi (13) and Katavi (15) regions show very low population density. Ten regions with population densities below the national population density include Ruvuma (22), Singida (28), Geita (28), Tabora (30), Morogoro (31), Manyara (32), Pwani (34), Mbeya (45) and Dodoma (50). Notable regions with quite high population densities are Kusini Pemba (588), Kaskazini Unguja (399), Kaskazini Pemba (369) and Mwanza (293).
