

Tanzania proportion of private households using improved toilet facilities





Improved toilet facility includes any toilet facility which meets any of the following classifications namely: Flush/Pour water to Piped Sewer System, Flush/Pour water to Septic Tank Flush/Pour water to Covered Pit, Flush/Pour water to Somewhere Else, Ventilated Improved Pit Latrine, Pit Latrine with Washable Slab with Lid. The 2012 PHC revealed that 24.3 percent of all private households were found to have improved toilet facility. Looking at the regional variations, Mjini Magharibi had the biggest proportion of private households which had improved toilet facilities (91.7 percent). Other regions which also had high proportions of private households with improved toilet facilities were Kusini Unguja (72.2), Dar es Salaam (63.0) and Kaskazini Unguja (53.6). Regions which had less than 10 percent of private households with improved toilet facilities were Simiyu (7.2), Kigoma (7.8), Mtwara (8.2) and Kagera and Singida (8.5 each).
