HOTEL STATISTICS JUNE, 2010


July, 2010

The National Bureau of Statistics has initiated a monthly survey of hotel occupancy. Out of 109 hotels surveyed, 51 responded.

The occupancy rate for July is estimated at 37.9 percent. There were 90,270 beds occupied out of which 53.6 percent were by international visitors.

Results further showed that in the month of July the rates increased by 2.3 percent compared to the previous month.

When compared with the same month last year (i.e. Jul, 2009) the result shows that bed occupancy rate increased by 1.9 percent as can be deduced from the table.

- Bed occupancy rate is expressed as the percentage of the total number of beds utilized over the total number of beds available.
- > Bed nights available are a function of the number of days in a month.
