

## Proportion of private houesholds that own land/farm



About 70 percent of all private households in Tanzania owned land or farm. This is because majority of Tanzanians live in rural areas. There are variations among regions on ownership of land or farm. For example, ownership of land or farm in Dar es Salaam which is predominantly urban and Dodoma varies, since 24 percent of households in Dar es Salaam own land/farm while about 84 percent of households in Dodoma own land or farm. Mjini Magharibi (21.8 percent) and Dar es Salaam (24.0 percent) recorded the lowest proportion of households which owned land or farm. Regions which recorded more than 80 percent of households that owned land or farm are Njombe (88.0), Ruvuma (87.9), Kagera (87.3), Mtwara (87.2), Kigoma (86.5), Singida (86.2), Lindi (85.1), Dodoma (84.2) and Rukwa
