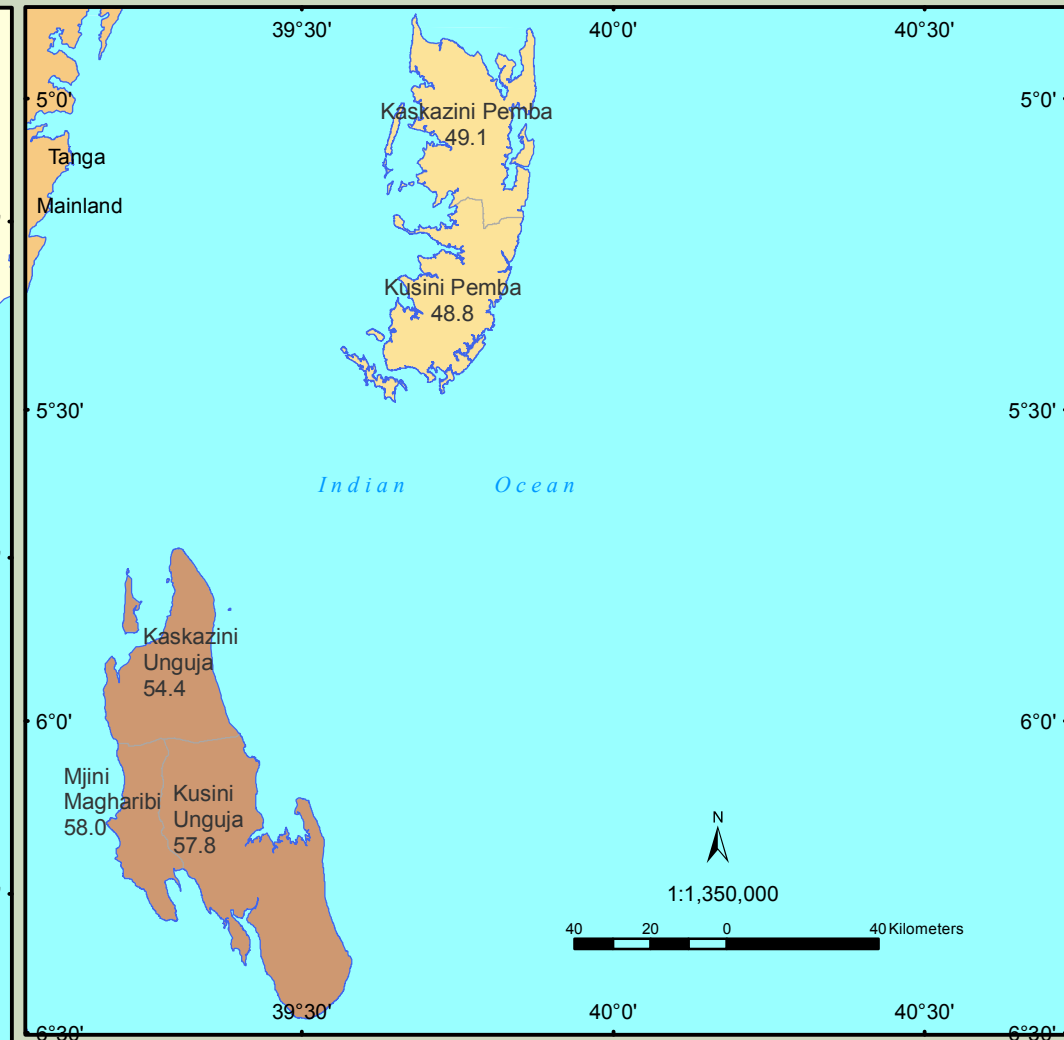
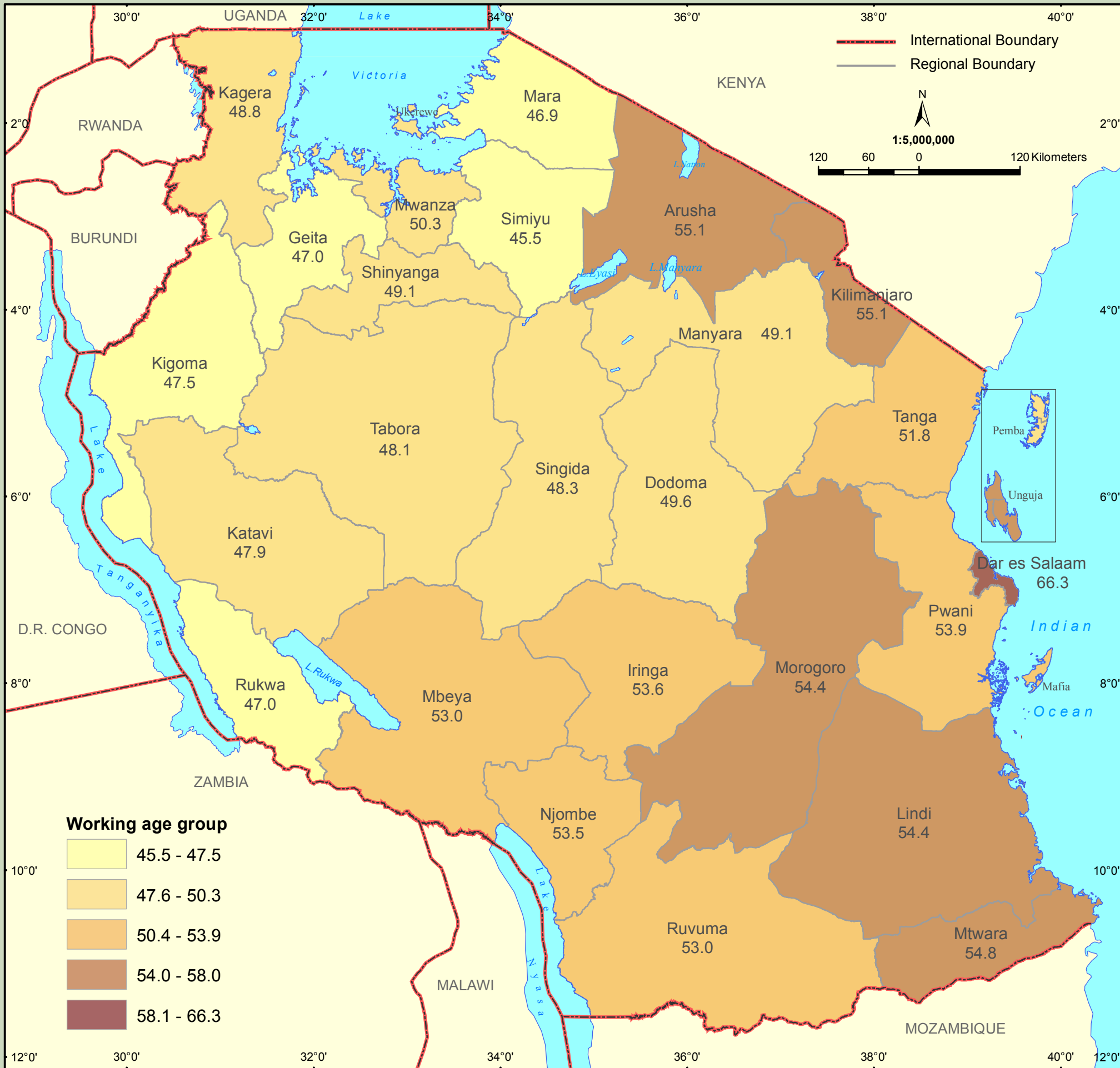


Proportion of aged 15 - 64 years (working age group)



The proportion of the country's total population aged 15-64 years constitutes the working age population. The proportion of the population aged 15-64 for Tanzania in the 2012 PHC was 52.2 percent representing a slight increase from 51.9 percent recorded in 2002 Census. The proportions which were observed in the regions of Tanzania vary. Dar es Salaam recorded the highest proportion of the population aged 15-64 years (66.3 percent) and was followed by Mjini Magharibi (58.0 percent) and Kusini Unguja (57.8 percent). Regions which had lowest proportions of the population aged 15-64 include Simiyu (45.5 percent), Mara (46.9 percent), Rukwa (47.0 percent), Kigoma (47.5 percent) and Katavi (47.9 percent). Other regions recorded proportions between 48.0 percent and 57.7 percent.
