



Proportion of university education age (20-25 years)



The proportion of the population age between 20 and 25 refers to the population which is expected to be university or other higher learning institution. The national figure of 10.7 percent which was observed in the 2015 PHC is the proportion of the population which refers to the segment of the population which is expected to be attending university or higher level of education. The 2012PHC revealed that Dar es Salaam recorded the biggest proportion of the population aged between 20 and 25 years. Other regions which also recorded high proportions were Mjini Magharibi (12.8 percent) and Kusini Unguja (12.3 percent). There were, however, other regions which recorded low proportions of population aged between 20 and 25 years. These regions, among others, include Kilimanjaro (9.2 percent), Lindi (9.3 percent), Mtwara (9.4 percent), Singida (9.5 percent), Simiyu, Tanga, Mara and Kaskazini Pemba (9.7 percent each), Kusini Pemba (9.8 percent) and Kigoma (9.9 percent). The proportion of the population aged between 20 and 25 of the remaining regions lie between 10.0 and 12.2 percent.
