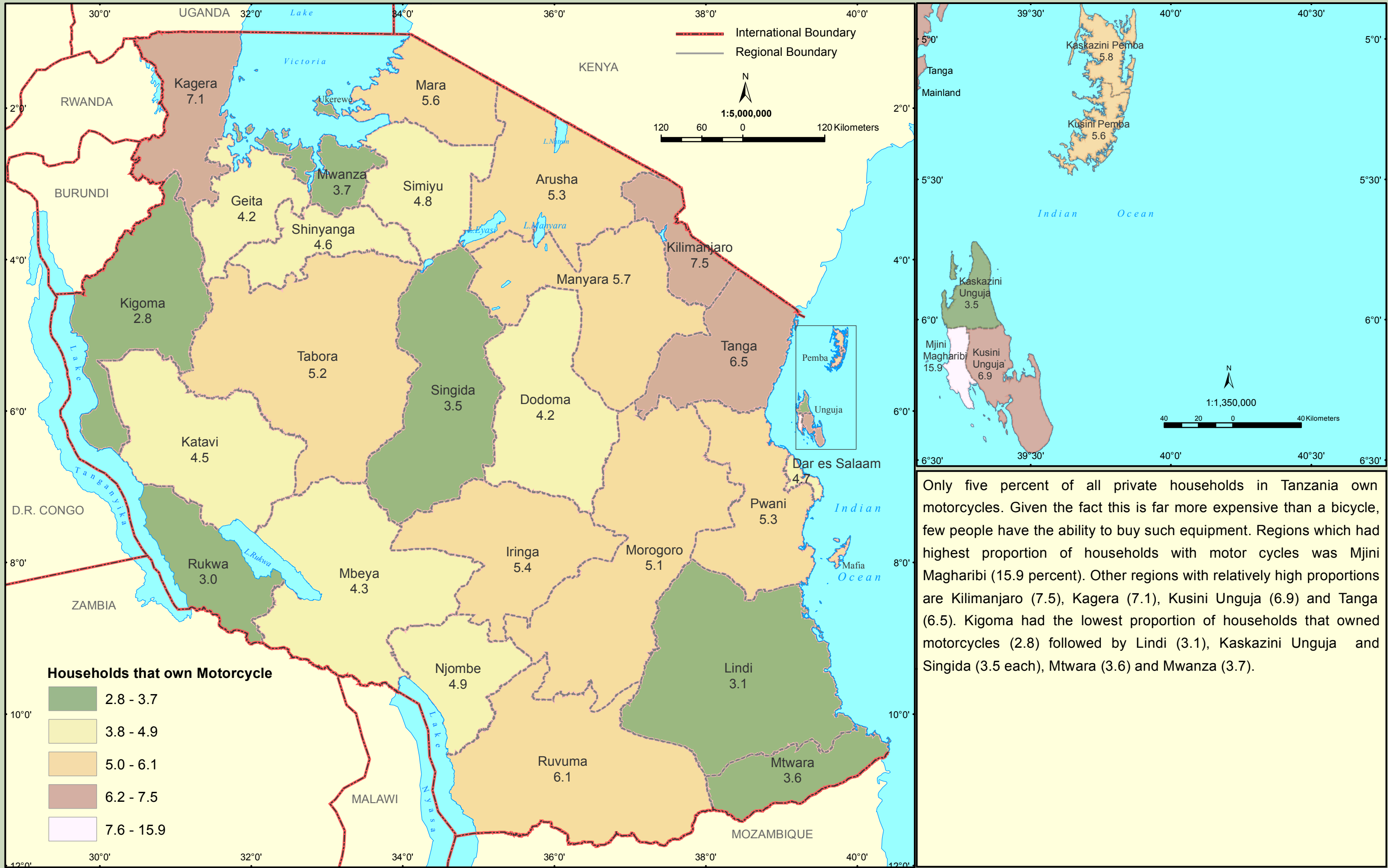


# Proportion of private households that own motorcycle/vespa



Only five percent of all private households in Tanzania own motorcycles. Given the fact this is far more expensive than a bicycle, few people have the ability to buy such equipment. Regions which had highest proportion of households with motor cycles was Mjini Magharibi (15.9 percent). Other regions with relatively high proportions are Kilimanjaro (7.5), Kagera (7.1), Kusini Unguja (6.9) and Tanga (6.5). Kigoma had the lowest proportion of households that owned motorcycles (2.8) followed by Lindi (3.1), Kaskazini Unguja and Singida (3.5 each), Mtwara (3.6) and Mwanza (3.7).
