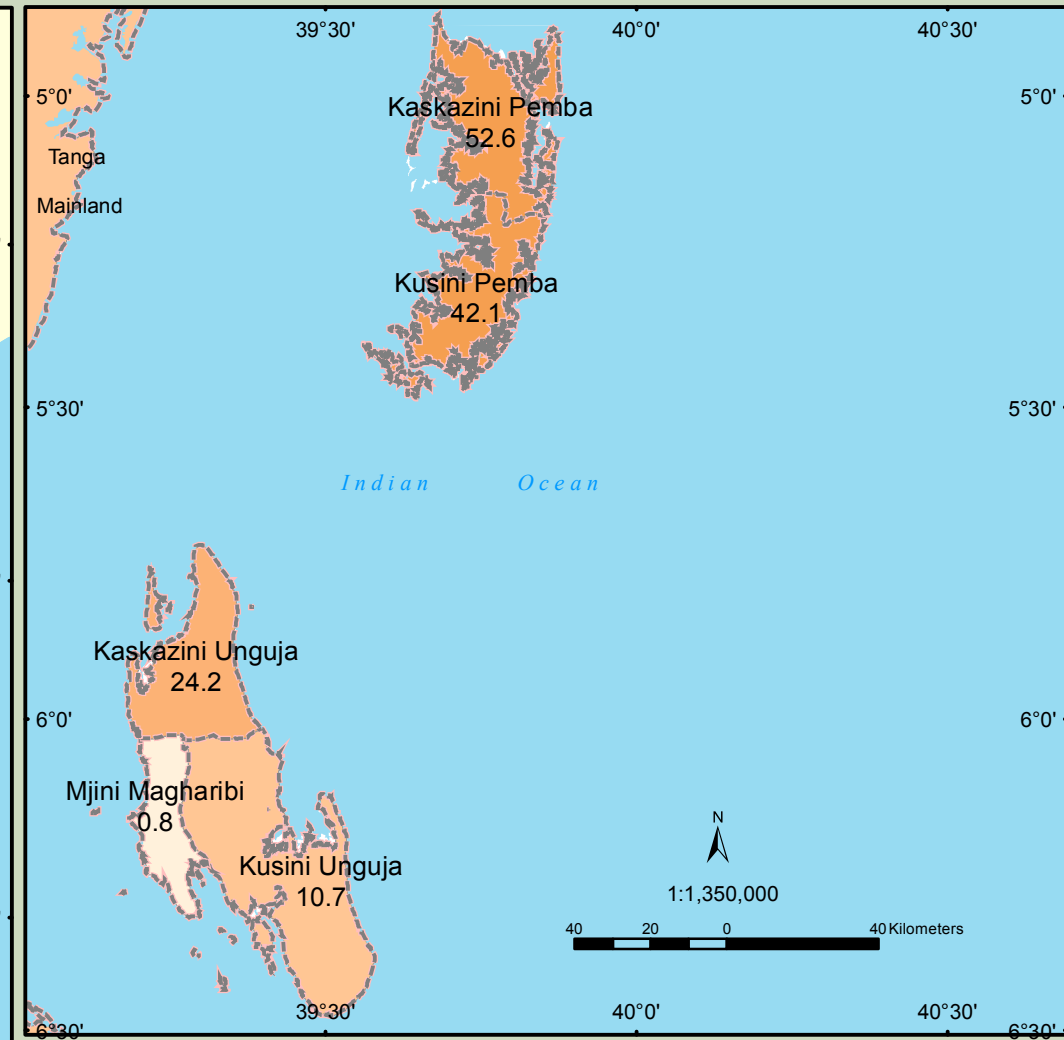
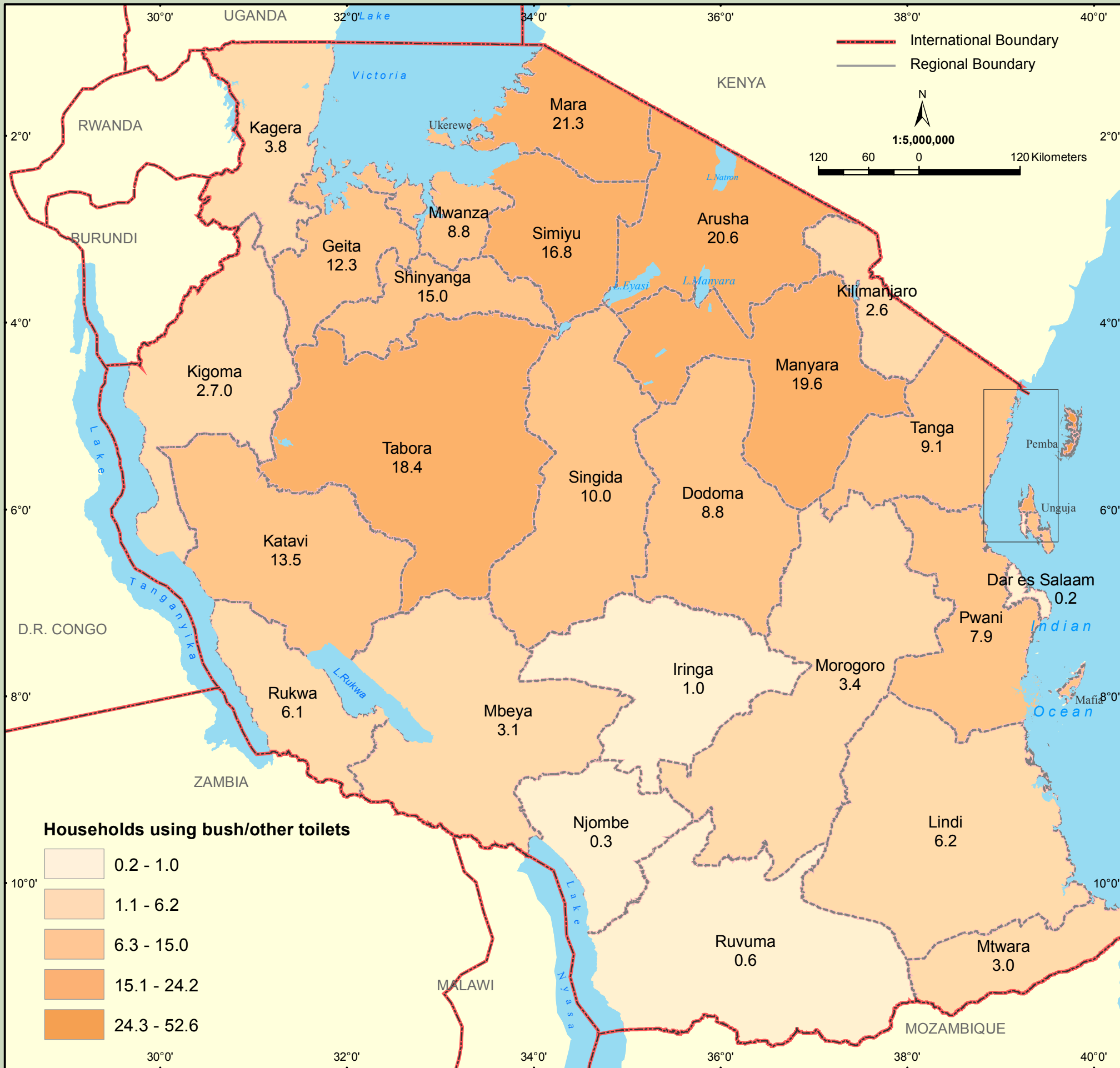


# Tanzania proportion of private households using other/bush toilet facilities



Previous population and housing censuses had shown that there are private households which do not have toilet facilities. The 2012 PHC showed that 7.8 percent of the Tanzania's private households did not have toilet. Although there is a slight improvement between 2002 and 2012 from about 9 percent in 2002 to 7.8 percent in 2012, the existence of private households without toilet facility poses a health hazard. At regional level, the prevalence of such households without toilet facility ranges between 0.2 percent observed in Dar es Salaam Region and 52.6 recorded in Kaskazini Pemba. Regions with the lowest proportion of private households with no toilet facility are Njombe (0.3 percent), Ruvuma (0.6 percent), Mjini Magharibi (0.8 percent) and Iringa (1.0 percent). On the other hand, regions with the highest proportion of private households without toilet facility include Kaskazini Pemba (52.6 percent), Kusini Pemba (42.1 percent), Kaskazini Uguja (24.2 percent), Mara (21.3 percent), Manyara (19.6 percent) and Tabora (18.4 percent).
