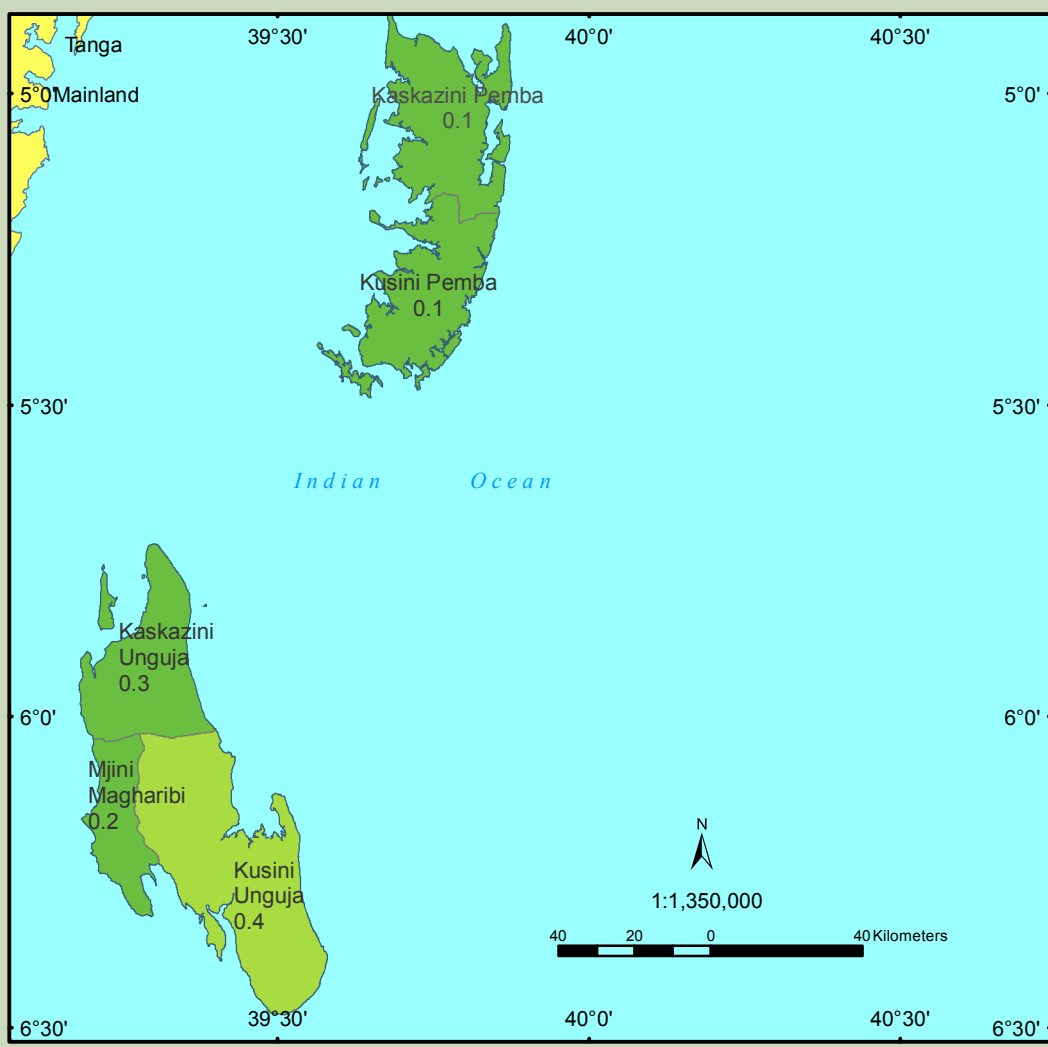
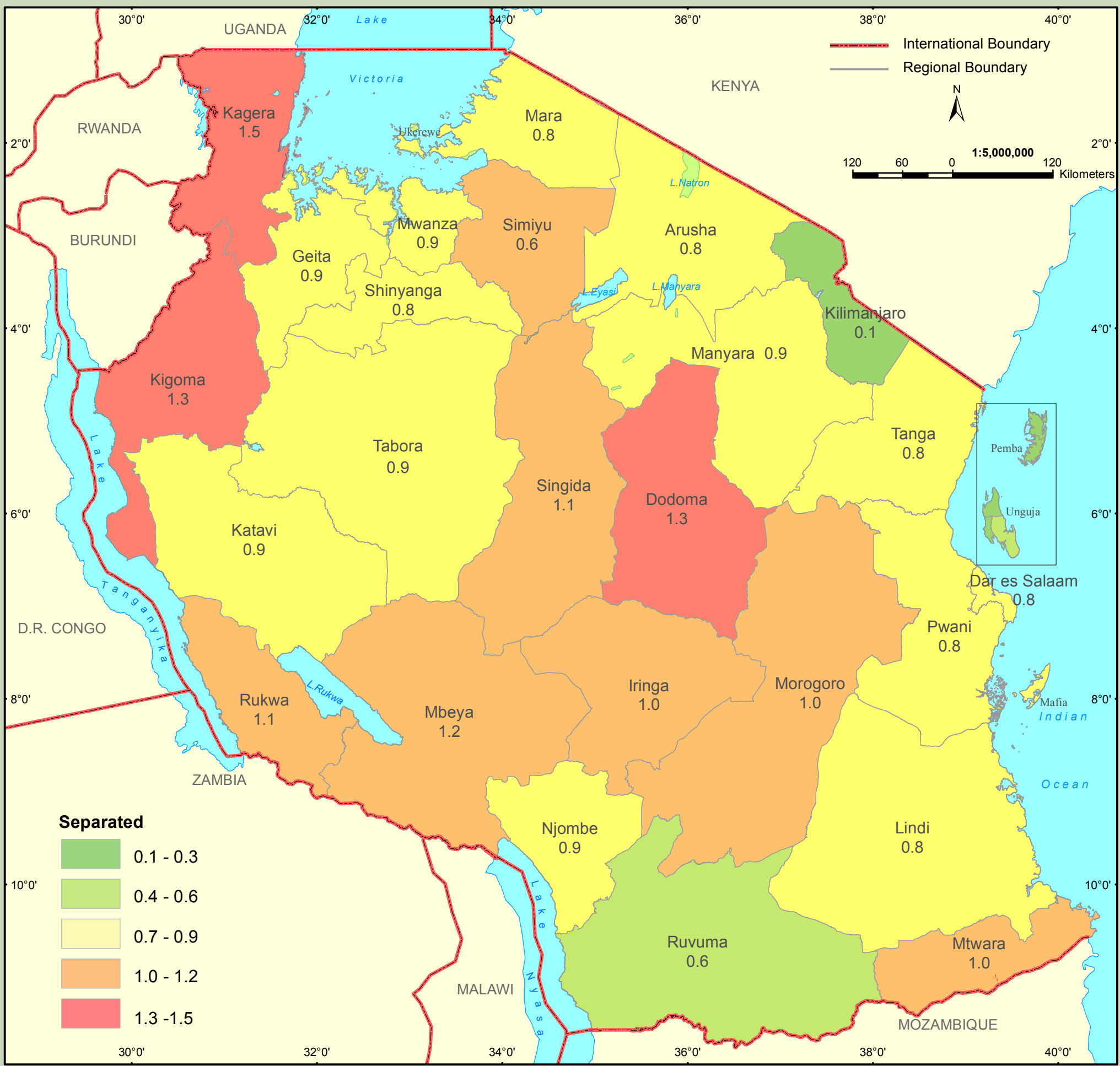


Married status by region; Separated



Separated is the act of persons who were once married but now are living apart. Those who live apart because their spouses are employed far away from home or for similar reasons are considered to be married. Based on this definition, less than one percent (0.9) of the population aged 15 years and above were separated. The proportion of persons aged 15 years and above who were separated in Tanzania were about one percent (0.9 percent). Males had a lower proportion (0.7 percent) than that of females (1.2 percent). At the regional level, the highest proportion of persons aged 15 years and above who were separated were in Dodoma (1.3 percent), Kigoma (1.3 percent) and Kagera (1.5 percent). Regions with the lowest proportions were Kaskazini Pemba and Kusini Pemba (0.1 percent each). Other regions with low proportions that were separated were Mjini Magharibi (0.2 percent) and Kaskazini Unguja (0.3 percent).
