## General Information about National Bureau of Statistics

The National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) has been established as an autonomous public office by the Statistics Act No. 9 of 2015 and has the mandate to provide official statistics to the Government, business community and the public at large. The Act also gives NBS the mandate to play the role as a co-coordinating agency, within the National Statistical System (NSS) to ensure that quality official statistics is produced. Before the enactment of the Statistics Act of 2015, the NBS was one of the Government Executive Agencies which was established on the 26<sup>th</sup> March, 1999 under the Executive Agencies Act, 1997.

The NBS which is the central depository for all official statistics produced in Tanzania, is responsible for the collection, compilation, analysis and dissemination of official statistics. Specifically, the services offered by NBS, include:

- 1. To collect data from various sources, analyze, publish, and distribute to stakeholders,
- To conduct surveys and provide technical advice on sampling, statistical data collection, processing, analysis and dissemination of collected data whenever requested by a user/ stakeholder,
- 3. To develop standards, methods and provide interpretation of concepts and definitions,
- 4. To provide raw data for researchers and other stakeholders,
- 5. To prepare maps needed for various surveys and censuses, and
- 6. To provide professional advice and instructions on how to use Statistical information according to specific customer requirement.

# Tanzania Mainland

Tanzania Mainland constitutes a total land area of 881,289 km<sup>2</sup> and 59,050 km<sup>2</sup> is covered by inland water and part of Indian Ocean. Tanzania Mainland population was projected at 52.6 million in the year 2018.

The population of Tanzania Mainland is projected at 52.6 million in 2018 based on the 2012 population and housing census of which 25.7 million were males and 26.9 million were females.

# Tanzania Mainland Economic Performance

The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant prices in 2018 amounted to Tshs115.1 trillion compared to Tshs.107.7 trillion recorded in 2017.

In 2018, the GDP grew at 7.0%. The average GDP growth rate from the year 2013 to 2018 was 6.7%. The highest and lowest growth rates of 7.0% and 6.2% were recorded for the year 2018 and 2015 respectively.

The GDP at current prices in 2018 amounted to Tshs.129.4 trillion compared to Tshs.118.7 trillion recorded in 2017. In the year 2018, Per Capita GDP increased to Tshs. 2,458.5 thousand from Tshs. 2,327.4 thousand recorded in 2017.









## The Gross Value Added (GVA) at current prices of Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing Activities, 2018





The gross value added of crops production at constant prices increased to TShs. 15.6 trillion in 2018 from TShs. 14.9 trillion in the year 2017, which is equivalent to an increase of 5.0 percent.

#### Mining and Quarrying

In 2018, the gross value added of Mining and Quarrying at constant prices increased to TShs. 4.7 trillion from TShs. 4.6 trillion in 2017 equivalent to an increase of 1.5 percent.
