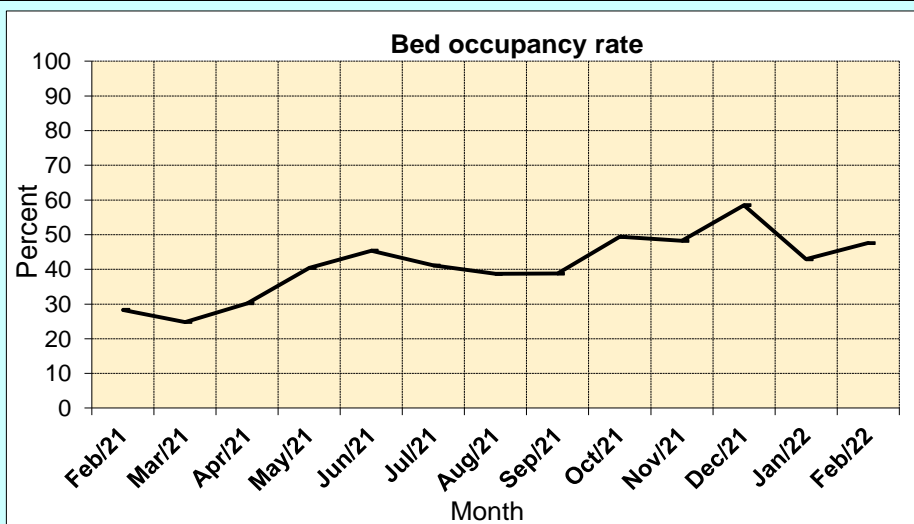
### HOTEL STATISTICS February, 2022

The National Bureau of Statistics conducts a monthly sample survey of hotel statistics to produce hotel bed occupancy rate. In the month of February, out of 184 hotels surveyed, 124 responded.

The occupancy rate for February was estimated at 47.6 percent. There were 142,821 beds occupied out of which 45.1 percent were international visitors.

Results further showed that in the month of February the bed occupancy rate increased by 4.7 percent compared to the previous month.

When compared with the same month last year (i.e. February, 2021) the result shows the increase rate of 19.3 percent bed occupancy as can be calculated from the table. The increase in the bed occupancy rate is attributed by the relaxation of travel restrictions due to COVID 19 Pandemic in many countries.

#### Note:

- Sample replacement due to closure and emergency of hotels with 30 or more employees.
- The Sample survey covers: -
  - All hotels on the Mainland with 30 or more employees.
  - Systematically sampled hotels with 29 employees or less.
- Provisional estimates are made for the hotels not responding.
- Bed occupancy rate is expressed as the percentage of the total number of beds utilized over the total number of beds available.
- Bed nights available are a function of the number of days in a month.
