HOTEL STATISTICS JANUARY, 2017

The National Bureau of Statistics has initiated a monthly survey of hotel occupancy. Out of 184 hotels surveyed, 88 responded.

The occupancy rate for January was estimated at 21.6 percent. There were 83,730 beds occupied out of which 53.5 percent were by international visitors.

Results further showed that in the month of January the rates decreased by 1.5 percent compared to the preceeding month.

When compared with the same month last year (i.e. Jan 2016) the result shows that bed occupancy rate declined by 3.5 percent as can be calculated from the table.

- Bed occupancy rate is expressed as the percentage of the total number of beds utilized over the total number of beds available.
- > Bed nights available are a function of the number of days in a month.
