
HOTEL STATISTICS MARCH, 2017

The National Bureau of Statistics has initiated a monthly survey of hotel occupancy. Out of 184 hotels surveyed, 89 responded.

The occupancy rate for March was estimated at 28.9 percent. There were 92,255 beds occupied out of which 43.4 percent were by international visitors.

Further results showed that in the month of March the rates increased by 0.3 percent compared to the preceding month.

When compared with the same month last year (i.e. March 2016) the result shows that bed occupancy rate inclined by 1.6 percent as can be calculated from the table.

- Bed nights available are a function of the number of days in a month.
