
HOTEL STATISTICS SEPTEMBER, 2016

The National Bureau of Statistics has initiated a monthly survey of hotel occupancy. Out of 184 hotels surveyed, 95 responded.

The occupancy rate for September was estimated at 31.9 percent. There were 102,466 beds occupied out of which 41.6 percent were by international visitors.

Results further showed that in the month of September the rates decreased by 0.9 percent compared to the previous month.

When compared with the same month last year (i.e. Sep 2015) the result shows that bed occupancy rate increased by 0.1 percent as can be calculated from the table.

- Bed nights available are a function of the number of days in a month.
