



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Preface

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) compilation in Mainland Tanzania is consistent with the international guidelines specifically the **System of National Accounts 2008** (2008 SNA), and the **International Standard of Industrial Classification Revision. 4** (ISIC Rev 4) used to classify all economic activities. The use of internationally agreed standards makes it possible to compare findings from Mainland Tanzania with other countries' Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP).

Findings in these reports facilitate frequent and appropriate policy interventions using available reliable and timely information on recent short-term economic developments. The term "quarter" in this report refers to a period of three months of the Calendar Year (January – March, April – June, July- September and October – December). The main data sources used in the compilation of these reports were administrative data from all economic activities undertaken during the reference period.

The third QGDP presents total value of goods and services derived from all economic activities performed in Mainland Tanzania for the period of July to September 2025. The third QGDP in this report is presented in absolute terms at current prices and constant 2015 prices. Moreover, other items presented are shares to GDP and growth rates by economic activity presented as percentages.

I sincerely thank all our stakeholders in both the public and private sectors for providing the key data that made this report possible. The National Bureau of Statistics is committed to continuing this partnership to improve our statistical system and the availability of essential data. This work is vital for accurately tracking economic progress and national development.

1.0 Introduction

This report presents Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP) being one of economic indicators that shows trend of performance for all economic activities at current and constant prices for Mainland Tanzania. The QGDP facilitates frequent and appropriate policy interventions by providing reliable and timely reports on recent short-term economic developments.

1.1. World Economy

The World Economic Outlook (WEO) report released by the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in October 2025 indicates that the global economy is projected to grow at 3.2 in percent in 2025. This represents an increase of 0.2 percentage points compared to the 3.0 percent growth rate projected in the WEO report released in July 2025. The upward revision in global growth is attributed to ongoing improvement in trade conditions including the decline in the actual average effective U.S. tariff rates to the levels announced in April. This development has contributed to easing pressures on international trade flows.


1.2. Sub-Saharan Africa

According to WEO report of October 2025, economic growth in Sub-Saharan countries is projected to grow at 4.1 percent in 2025, compared to 4.0 percent projected in July 2025 WEO report. South Africa's economy is projected to grow by 1.1 percent in 2025 compared to 1.0 percent estimated in July 2025 WEO report, representing the upward revision of 0.1 percentage points. Meanwhile, Nigeria's economic growth is projected at 3.9 percent, higher than 3.4 percent estimated in July 2025 WEO report.

1.3. Southern Africa Development Community

Assessment of economic growth of selected countries in the Southern African Development Community (SADC) for the period of July to September 2025 indicated that South Africa's economy grew by 0.5 percent, up from negative 0.3 percent growth recorded in 2024. Namibia's economy expanded by 1.9 percent in the third quarter of 2025, from 2.1 percent observed in the corresponding period in 2024. Botswana's economy grew by 8.2 percent in the third quarter of 2025, compared to a negative growth rate of 4.0 percent recorded during the same period in 2024. Furthermore, the economy of Tanzania grew to 6.4 percent in 2025, compared to a growth rate of 6.1 percent recorded during the same period in 2024.

Figure 1: Third Quarter GDP Growth Rates for Selected SADC Countries in 2024 and 2025



1.4. East African Community

The East Africa Community Partner States, that have published reports on economic performance during the third quarter of 2025 are Tanzania, Rwanda Uganda and Kenya. During the period under review, the economic growth rates of Rwanda and Uganda increased to 11.8 percent and 4.8 percent, compared with 6.8 percent and 6.2 percent respectively, during the same period in 2024. The economy of Kenya grew by 4.9 percent, compared to a growth rate of 4.2 percent recorded during the same period in 2024. Moreover, Tanzania's economy grew by 6.4 percent up, from 6.1 percent recorded in the corresponding period in 2024. Reports on economic performance for the remaining East Africa Community Partner States in the third quarter GDP 2025 have not yet been published on the websites of respective National Statistical Offices (Figure 2).

1.5. GDP Compilation in Mainland Tanzania


The National Bureau of Statistics is also implementing the National Accounts Revision Policy that became operational in 2019. The policy allows publication of provisional results subject to availability of new or revised quarterly and/or annual data. Gross Domestic Product estimates have been aligned to the revised balance of payment statistics released by Bank of Tanzania for the period from 2017 to 2024.

The compilation of National Accounts Statistics for the third quarter GDP (July – September) 2025 utilized data collected from all economic activities conducted in the country.

1.5.1 Third Quarter GDP Growth Rate 2025

During the period under review, the third quarter Gross Domestic Product (QGDP) 2025 at current prices in absolute terms increased to TZS 53.7 trillion, from TZS 48.7 trillion recorded in the similar quarter in 2024. Furthermore, GDP at constant 2015 prices increased to TZS 40.0 trillion in the third quarter 2025, from TZS 37.6 trillion registered in the corresponding period in 2024, equivalent to 6.4 percent growth (**Figure 3**).

Figure 3: Third Quarter GDP Growth Rates, 2021 – 2025



1.5.2 Share to GDP by Broad Economic Classification

Analysis of activities based on Broad Economic Classification (BEC) revealed that during the period under review, **Tertiary Activities** accounted for the largest share of **41.4 percent**, followed by **Primary Activities (34.8 percent)** and **Secondary Activities (23.8 percent)**. Note that shares to GDP were compiled before adjustment for taxes.

Figure 4: Share to GDP by Broad Economic Activities at Current Prices



1.5.3 Third Quarter GDP Growth by Economic Activities, 2025

During the period of July to September 2025, GDP at constant prices increased by 6.4 percent from 6.1 percent growth recorded in the corresponding period in 2024. Economic activities that recorded significant growth rates were: **Financial and Insurance (14.2 percent); Electricity (13.6 percent); Information and Communication (12.3 percent); Arts, Entertainment & Recreation (10.5 percent); and Mining and Quarrying (7.1 percent)**; (Figure 5).

1.5.4 Contribution to Growth

All economic activities that took place between July and September 2025 contributed differently to the growth of 6.4 percent. During the reference period, **Construction activity recorded the largest contribution to growth of 15.0 followed by Agriculture (14.8 percent); Financial and Insurance (9.9 percent); Trade and Repair (8.6 percent); and Transport and Storage (8.0 percent) and Mining and Quarrying (7.1 percent)**.

2.0 Sectoral Performance

This section provides highlights of the economic activities carried out and their corresponding growth rates between the third quarter of 2025 and 2024. Activities outlined in the sub-sections include crop production, livestock, forestry, and fishing. Other economic activities covered are mining and quarrying, manufacturing, electricity, water supply, and construction. In addition, the section outlines other sectors such as trade and repairs; transportation and storage; accommodation and food services; information and communication; financial and insurance services; real estate; professional, technical and scientific services; public administration and defense-related services; as well as education, human health, arts, entertainment and recreation; and other services activities.

2.1 Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing


This sector includes exploitation of vegetables and animal natural resources that comprise of growing crops, raising and breeding of animals, harvesting of timber and other plants, animals or animal products from a farm or their natural habitats. During the period between July and September 2025, Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing increased by 5.1 percent compared to 4.9 percent achieved during the similar period in 2024.

2.1.1 Crops

Major crops covered include maize, paddy, sorghum/millet, other cereals, cassava, round potatoes, sweet potatoes, other roots and tubers, beans and other pulses, dried oil seeds, other vegetables, bananas, other fruits, cashew nuts, coffee, cotton, tea, tobacco and other food and cash crops.

The crops sub activity expanded by 4.8 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 4.9 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in crop production, which benefited from the use of enhanced technology and inputs, including extension services.

Crops that contributed the most to the growth of crop production activity during the third quarter of 2025 includes paddy, oil seeds, beans and pulses; and wheat. During the reference period, paddy production increased by 9.4 percent from 434 thousand tonnes in 2024 to 475 thousand tonnes in 2025. Production of beans and pulses rose by 4.6 percent, from 87 thousand tonnes in 2024 to 91 thousand tonnes in 2025. Furthermore, oilseed production increased by 7.3 percent, from 41 thousand tonnes in 2024 to 44 thousand tonnes in 2025. Similarly, wheat production grew by 29.6 percent, from 27 thousand tonnes in 2024 to 35 thousand tonnes in 2025.

2.1.2 Livestock

The activity covers livestock rearing activities, improved and indigenous cattle; goats; sheep; donkeys and horses; guinea pigs and rabbits; indigenous and commercial chicken; and other poultry.

During the period of July to September 2025, livestock activity recorded the growth rate of 5.1 percent, similar to the growth rate observed in the corresponding period in 2024. The demand for livestock-based products, increase in per capita income, urbanization, taste preference as well as increased awareness on food nutrition attributed to the growth.

2.1.3 Forestry and Logging

Forestry and Logging The activity covers production of timber, charcoal, fuel wood and Logs, twigs, faggots (bundle of branches) and non-wood forest products.

Forestry activity expanded by 6.2 percent in the third quarter of 2025, maintaining the same growth rate recorded in the corresponding quarter of 2024. This performance was largely attributed to government interventions aimed at promoting sustainable harvesting and management of forest products.

2.1.4 Fishing

Fishing activity covers the harvest of fishery resources from marine or freshwater environments, with the goal of capturing fish, crustaceans, and other marine products. Fishing activity recorded a growth rate of 4.2 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 2.2 percent registered in the corresponding quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to Government efforts to ensure sustainable fish catch and fish products.

2.2 Mining and Quarrying

Mining and Quarrying Mining and quarrying include the activities of extraction of minerals occurring naturally as solids (coal and ores), liquids (petroleum) or gases (natural gas). Extraction can be from underground, on the surface mining or well operation. It also includes supplementary activities aimed at preparing the crude materials for marketing, for example, crushing and grinding; cleaning, drying, sorting, concentrating ores, liquefaction of natural gas and agglomeration of solid fuels. The units located nearby often accomplish the operations. Mining and quarrying activity is divided into four industries, which are:

- i. Mining of coal, lignite, and extraction of peat.
- ii. Crude petroleum and natural gas.
- iii. Mining of metal ores; and

iv. Other mining and quarrying.

The activity grew by 7.1 percent in the third quarter of 2025, compared to the 13.9 percent recorded during the same quarter in 2024. The changes were due to the increase in production for some minerals, including Gold, Diamond, Phosphate, Kaolin, Limestone, Pozzolana and Sapphire (**Table 1**).

2.3 Manufacturing

Manufacturing activity involves physical or chemical transformation of materials, substances, or components into final or semi processed goods. The materials include products of agriculture, forestry, fishing, mining and quarrying as well as products of other manufacturing activities.

The activity recorded a growth rate of 4.5 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 5.0 percent registered in the corresponding quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in the production of manufactured goods.

2.4 Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply

The activity covers provision of electric power and natural gas, through permanent infrastructure (network) of lines, mains, and pipes. Specifically, the activity involves generation of electricity mainly from hydro, thermal and gas sources. It also includes electricity transmission and distribution activities. The primary sources of electricity generation data include the power generation companies such as TANESCO.

The growth of electric generation activities depends on the amount of electricity produced and distributed to customers. During the third quarter of 2025, electric generation activities increased by 13.6 percent compared to 15.0 percent in the similar quarter of 2024. The growth was largely attributed to electricity generation from the Mwalimu Nyerere Dam. Is this reason justifiable by numbers – production? Not necessarily in the report.


2.5 Water Supply and Sewerage

The activity includes collection and purification of water for water supply purposes, desalting sea water to produce water as the principal product of interest and collection of water directly from wells for use by water supply companies or used on own account in agriculture or households. It also includes water distribution and the collection of wastewater activities.

The indicator for the growth of water supply activity is the quantity of water produced. During the reference period, the quantity of water produced increased to 107.6 million cubic meters from

102.9 million cubic meters recorded in the similar quarter in 2024. The activity grew at a rate of 4.4 percent in the third quarter of 2025 from 3.7 percent recorded in the corresponding quarter in 2024 (**Figure 7**).

2.6 Construction

This activity includes general construction and specialized construction activities for buildings and civil engineering works. It includes new work, repair, additions and alterations, the erection of prefabricated buildings or structures on the site and construction of temporary nature.

General construction deals with construction of entire dwellings, office buildings, stores and other public and utility buildings, farm buildings etc., It also includes construction of civil engineering works such as motorways, streets, bridges, tunnels, railways, airfields, harbours and water projects, irrigation systems, sewerage systems, industrial facilities, pipelines and electric lines, sports facilities etc.

During the third quarter of 2025, construction activity recorded a growth rate of 6.5 percent compared to 3.9 percent in the corresponding quarter in 2024. Growth of construction activities is assessed based on domestically produced goods as well as imported materials used in construction activities. The growth was attributed to an increase in local production of construction materials including cement, and iron steels.

2.7 Wholesale and Retail Trade; Repair of Motor Vehicles, Motorcycles and Personal and Household Goods

The activity includes wholesale and retail sales (sale without transformation) of any type of goods, as well as rendering services incidental to the sale of merchandise. It also includes repair of motor vehicles and installation and repair of personal and household goods. The activity involves buying and selling of goods.

During the third quarter of 2025, the activity recorded a growth rate of 6.4 percent compared to 4.8 in the third quarter of 2024. The growth was due to an increase in goods traded for agriculture, livestock, fishing, mining and quarrying, manufactured and imported goods.

2.8 Transport and Storage

This activity includes the provision of passenger or freight transport, whether scheduled or not, by rail, pipeline, road, water, or air and associated activities such as cargo handling, storage, etc. The activity also includes renting transport equipment with a driver or operator and postal and courier activities.

The activity expanded by 6.3 in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 5.7 percent registered in the similar quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in cargo tonnage and the number of passengers transported by road and Standard Gauge ailway transport services.

2.9 Accommodation and Food Services

This activity includes the provision of short-stay accommodation for visitors and other travelers, and provision of complete meals and drinks fit for immediate consumption. The amount and type of supplementary services provided within this section can vary widely.

In the third quarter of 2025, Accommodation and food services recorded a growth rate of 6.7 compared to 5.8 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in number of tourist arrivals. During the period under review, the number of tourist arrivals increased by 19.4 percent to 734,737, from 615,281 tourists recorded during the same period in 2024 as well as an increase in the number of bed occupancy.

2.10 Information and Communication

The activity covers publishing activities, motion picture, video and television programming production, sound recording and music publishing, programming and broadcasting activities, e.g., radio and television broadcasting, telecommunications, computer programming, consultancy and related activities, and information service activities e.g., data processing, and news agencies.


The activity recorded a growth rate of 12.3 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 14.5 percent in the same quarter of 2024. The growth rate was attributed to an increase in the number of voice traffic per minute; the number of short messages services traffic (SMS); the average number of mobile money subscribers and the expansion of broadcasting and internet services in the country.

Financial and Insurance Services

The activity covers financial services, insurance and reinsurance, voluntary pension funding, and auxiliary to financial services. It also includes the activities of holding assets, such as holding companies, trusts, funds, and similar financial entities.

The activity recorded a growth rate of 14.2 percent in the third quarter of 2025 as compared to 14.5 percent in the same quarter of 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase of 21.2 percent in level of deposits from TZS 39.2 trillion in the third quarter of 2024 to TZS 47.5 trillion in the same period in 2025. Also, an increase of 16.2 percent in level of lending from 37.1 trillion in the third quarter of 2024 to TZS 43.1 trillion in the corresponding period 2025.

2.11 Real Estate

This activity includes selling or buying real estate, renting real estate, and providing other real estate services such as appraising real estate. Activities in this industry may be carried out on own or leased property and may be done on a fee or contract basis. Also included is the building of structures, combined with maintaining ownership or leasing of such structures.

The activity increased by 4.4 percent in the third quarter of 2025, compared to 4.3 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in demand for accommodation services, especially in urban areas.

2.12 Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities

This activity includes specialized professional, scientific and technical activities. The activity requires high degree of training, as well as making specialized knowledge and skills available to users. The activity includes legal and accounting; activities of head offices; management consultancy; architectural and engineering; technical testing and analysis; scientific research and development; advertising and market research; other professional; scientific and technical as well as veterinary activities.

The activity expanded by 4.9 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 4.2 percent registered in the corresponding period in 2024. The expansion was attributed to an increase in professional, scientific and technical services during reference period.

2.13 Administrative and Support Services

The activity includes a variety of services that support general business operations. Administrative and support services involve rental and leasing; employment; travel agency; tour operator; reservation service and related activities; security and investigation; as well as services to buildings and landscape.

The activity recorded a growth of 3.8 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 6.1 percent observed in the similar quarter in 2024. The performance of travel agents and tour operators' services was attributed to an increase in number of tourist arrivals.

2.14 Public Administration and Defense; Compulsory Social Security

The activity includes the enactment and judicial interpretation of laws, legislative activities, taxation, national defense, public order and safety, immigration services, foreign affairs and the administration of government programmes. This activity also includes compulsory social security services.

The public administration and defense recorded a growth of 4.1 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 5.5 percent observed in the similar quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in Government salaries, arrears and other government expenditure for maintaining peace and order, as well as the provision of social services.

2.15 Education

This activity includes education at any level or for any profession, oral or written as well as by radio and television or other means of communication. It includes education by the different institutions in the regular school system at different levels as well as adult education, literacy programs etc. The activity includes public as well as private education.

Education activity increased to 5.4 percent up, during the period of July to September 2025, from 7.6 percent observed in the similar quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to an increase in the number of students enrolled at all levels of education in both public and private institutions.

2.16 Human Health and Social Work

The activity includes the provision of health and social services. It includes a wide range of activities, including health care provided by trained medical professionals in hospitals and other facilities, other residential care activities that still involve a degree of health care activities to social work activities without any involvement of health care professionals.

Human health and social work activity recorded a growth rate of 6.6 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to a growth rate of 10.8 percent registered in the similar quarter in 2024. The growth was attributed to a continued improvement in the provision of better health services at all levels.

2.17 Art, Entertainment and Recreation

This activity includes a wide range of activities with the objective of meeting varied cultural, entertainment and recreational interests of the public including live performances, operation of museum sites, gambling, sports and recreation activities.

In the third quarter of 2025, the activity recorded a growth rate of 10.5 percent, compared to a growth rate of 16.2 percent registered in the corresponding quarter of 2024. The growth of the activity was attributed to an increase in tourist arrivals.

2.18 Other Services Activities

This industry includes the activities of membership organizations; repair of computers and personal and household goods; and a variety of personal services not covered elsewhere in the classification. It also includes Activities of Households as Employers.

The activity recorded a growth rate of 4.8 percent in the third quarter of 2025 compared to 5.8 percent in the similar quarter in 2024. The growth of the activity was attributed to an increase in urban population and personal service activities.

3.0 Conclusion

During the third quarter of 2025, GDP at constant prices increased by 6.4 percent, from 6.1 percent recorded in the similar period in 2024. Economic activities that recorded significant growth included: Financial and Insurance activities (14.2 percent); Electricity supply (13.6 percent); Information and Communication (12.3 percent); Arts and Entertainment (10.5 percent); and Mining and Quarrying (7.1 percent)
