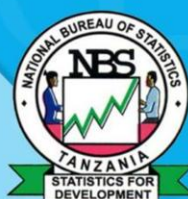

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Preface

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) compilation in Mainland Tanzania is consistent with the international guidelines, specifically the System of National Accounts 2008 (2008 SNA), and the International Standard of Industrial Classification of all Economic Activities Revision 4 (ISIC Rev 4) used to classify economic activities. The use of internationally agreed standards makes it possible to compare findings from Mainland Tanzania's Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP) with those of other countries.

The findings presented in this report facilitate frequent and appropriate policy interventions using available reliable and timely information on recent short-term economic developments. The calendar year is structured as follows: First quarter – January to March; Second quarter – April to June; Third quarter – July to September; and Fourth quarter – October to December. The sources of information include administrative data covering all economic activities undertaken during the reference period.

This report is the first to be published using rebased GDP estimates, with the base year 2019. The first QGDP report presents the total value of goods and services produced in the country by type of economic activity measured at current prices and at constant 2019 prices. Other information presented in the report includes percentage shares to GDP and growth rates by economic activity.

I sincerely thank all stakeholders from both the public and private sectors for providing the key data that made this report possible. The National Bureau of Statistics is committed to continuing this partnership to improve our statistical system and ensure the availability of essential data. This work is vital for accurately tracking economic progress and national development.

1.0. Introduction

The Quarterly Gross Domestic Product (QGDP) is one of the key economic indicators that provide detailed information on the performance of all economic activities on quarterly basis within a country. The QGDP facilitates frequent and appropriate policy interventions by providing reliable and timely information on recent short-term economic developments.

1.1. World Economy

According to the World Economic Outlook (WEO) report published in April 2026 by the International Monetary Fund (IMF), the baseline scenario which assumes ongoing geopolitical conflicts and wars remain short-lived or are largely contained, projects global economic growth of 3.1 percent in 2026. This represents a downward revision of 0.2 percentage points from the 3.3 percent growth forecast presented in the January 2026 edition. In addition, global headline inflation is projected to increase from 4.1 percent in 2025 to 4.4 percent in 2026. However, continued attacks on critical energy infrastructure and the possibility of a prolonged closure of the Strait of Hormuz could heighten downside risks to the global economic outlook. Such developments may lead to higher energy prices, stronger inflationary pressures, tighter financial conditions, and ultimately a slowdown in global economic growth.

1.2. Sub-Saharan Africa

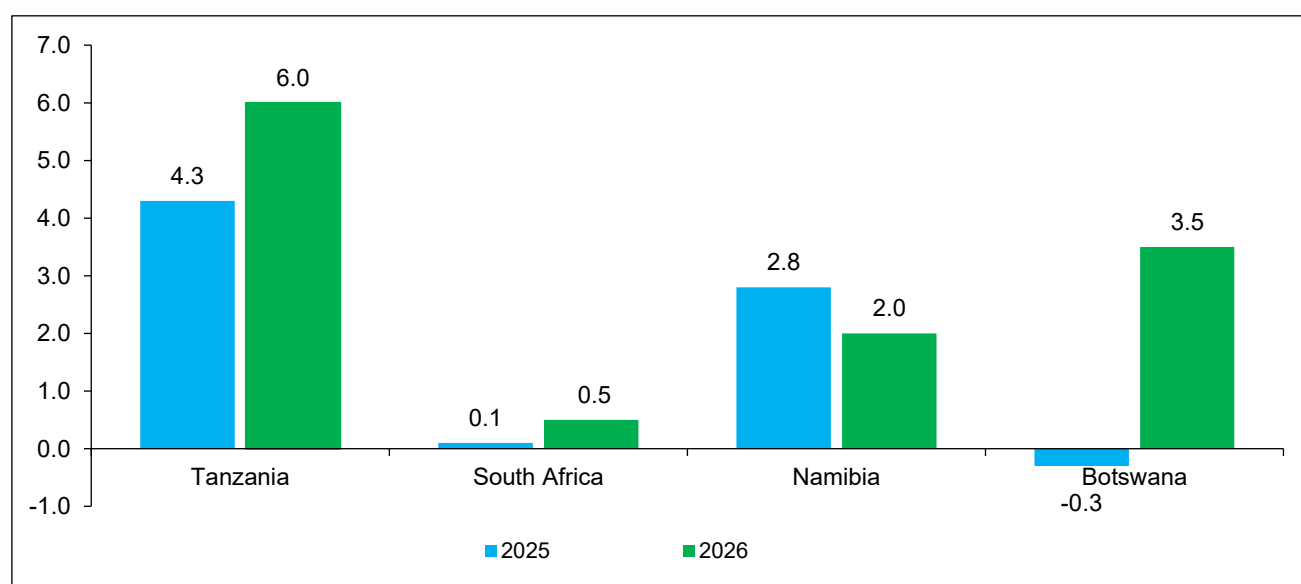
According to the WEO report posted in April 2026, economic growth in Sub-Sahara countries is projected to grow at 4.3 percent in 2026, compared with 4.6 percent projected in the WEO report issued in January 2026, representing a downward revision of 0.3 percentage points. South Africa's economy is projected to grow by 1.0 percent in 2026 compared with 1.4 percent estimated in the WEO report revealed in the January 2026 edition. Meanwhile, the WEO report published in April 2026 indicates that Nigeria's economic growth is projected at 4.1 percent compared to 4.4 percent estimated in the WEO report released in January 2026.

1.3. Southern Africa Development Community

Assessment of economic growth in the Southern African Development Community (SADC) for the period of January to March 2026 indicated that South Africa's economy grew by 0.5 percent compared with 0.1 percent noted during the corresponding period in 2025. Namibia's economy increased by 2.0 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with 2.8 percent observed in the corresponding period in 2025. Furthermore, Botswana's

economy increased by 3.5 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with 0.3 percent observed in the corresponding period in 2025. Tanzania's economy grew to 6.0 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with a growth rate of 4.3 percent recorded during the similar period in 2025. Furthermore, the trend of economic growth for other member countries of the Southern African Development Community for the period of January to March 2026 has not yet been published on websites of the respective national statistical offices.

Figure 1: First Quarter GDP Growth Rates for Selected SADC Countries in 2025 and 2026

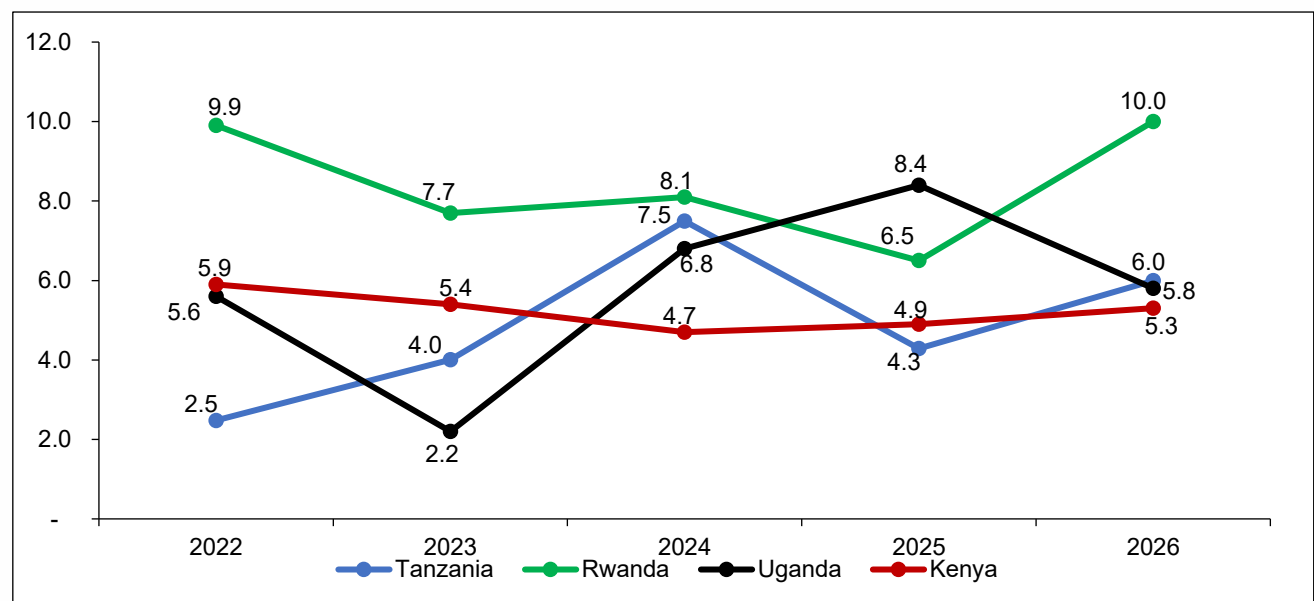

1.4. East African Community

The East Africa Community Partner States that have published reports on economic performance during the first quarter of 2026 indicate a sustained strengthening of positive economic growth. During the period under review, the economic growth rate of Rwanda increased to 10.0 percent from 6.5 percent noted during the similar period in 2025. The economy in Uganda grew by 5.8 percent compared with a growth rate of 8.4 percent recorded during the similar period in 2025. The economic growth of Kenya increased to 5.3 percent compared with 4.9 percent observed during the similar period in 2025. The economy in Tanzania grew by 6.0 percent compared with a growth rate of 4.3 percent recorded during the similar period in 2025. Reports on economic performance for the remaining East Africa Community Partner States for the first quarter of 2026 have not yet been published on the websites of the respective National Statistical Offices (Figure 2).

1.5. GDP Compilation in Mainland Tanzania

The National Bureau of Statistics is implementing the National Accounts Revision Policy, which became operational in 2019. The policy allows the publication of provisional results, subject to the availability of new or revised quarterly and/or annual data.

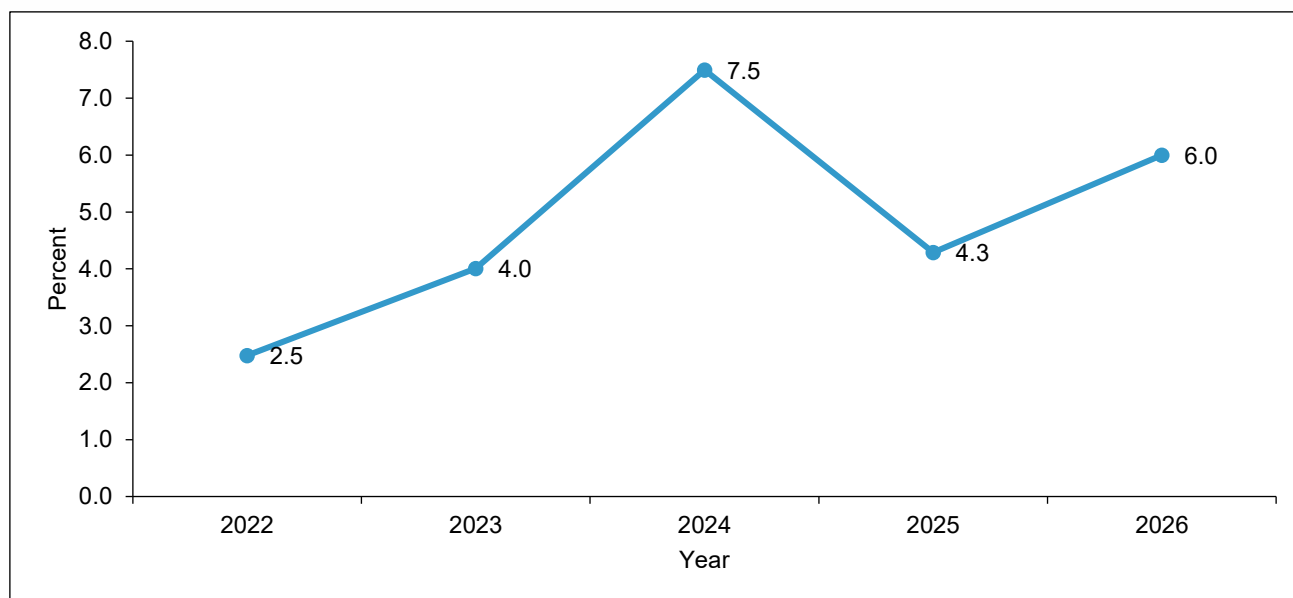
The compilation of National Accounts Statistics for the First Quarter GDP (January – March) 2026 was based on data collected from all economic activities conducted in the country for the reference period

1.5.1. First Quarter GDP 2026 Performance

During the period under review, the first quarter Gross Domestic Product 2026 at current prices in absolute terms increased to TZS 60.4 trillion, from TZS 53.2 trillion recorded in the similar quarter in 2025. Furthermore, GDP at constant 2019 prices increased to TZS 45.8 trillion in the first quarter of 2026 from TZS 43.2 trillion registered in the corresponding period in 2025 (Table1), equivalent to 6.0 percent growth (**Figure 3**).

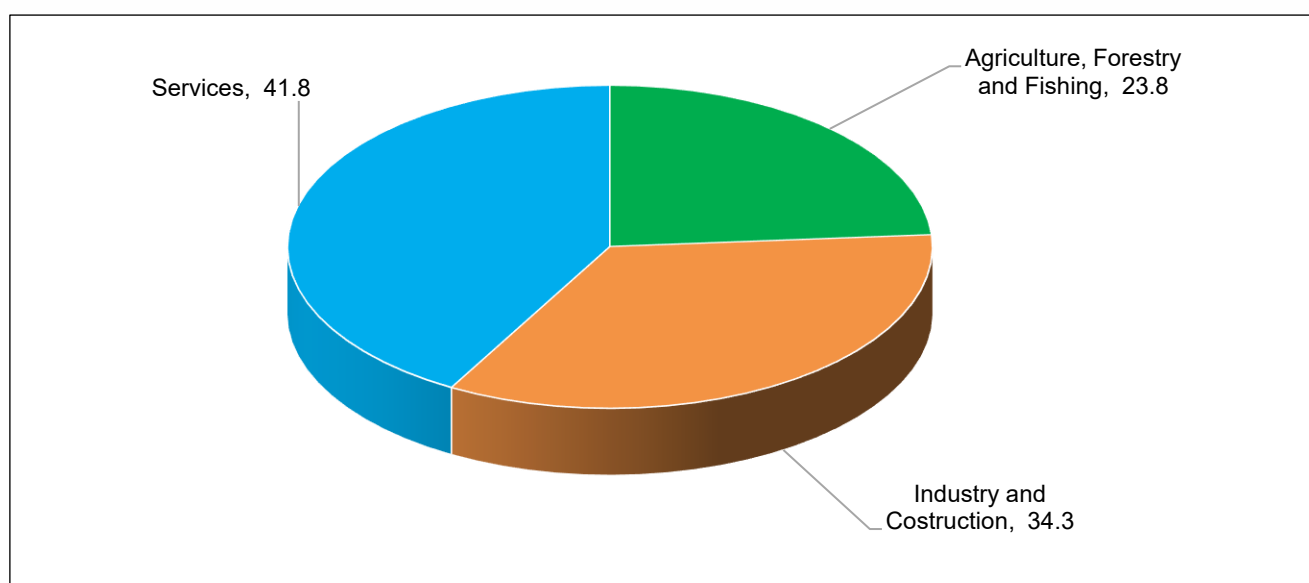

1.5.2. Share to GDP by Broad Economic Activities

Analysis of activities based on the Broad Economic Activities analysis revealed that during the period under review, **Services** activities accounted for the largest share of **41.8 percent**, followed by **Industry and Construction** activities (**34.3 percent**) and **Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing** activities (**23.8 percent**). Note that shares to GDP were compiled before adjustment for taxes.

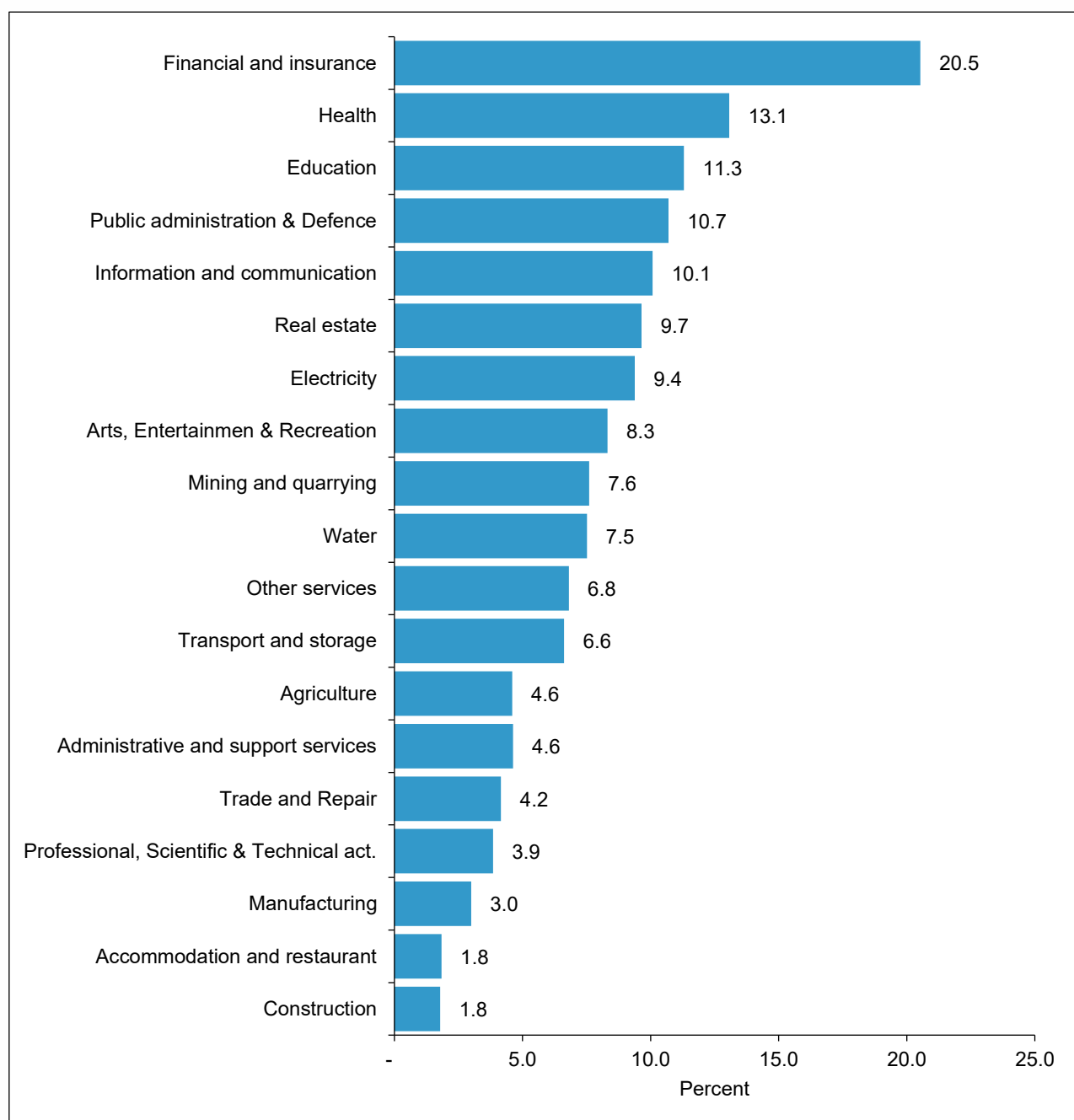
Figure 4: First quarter GDP by Broad Economic Activities at Current Prices 2026, Percentage Share

1.5.3. First Quarter GDP 2026 Growth Rates by Economic Activities

During the period of January to March 2026, GDP at constant 2019 prices increased by 6.0 percent compared to 4.3 percent growth recorded in the corresponding period in 2025. Economic activities that recorded significant growth rates were Financial and Insurance (20.5 percent); Health (13.1 percent); Education (11.3 percent); Public Administration & Defence (10.7 percent); Information and Communication (10.1 percent); Real estate (9.7 percent); and Electricity (9.4 percent) (**Figure 5**).

1.5.4. Contribution to GDP Growth

All economic activities that took place between January and March 2026 contributed differently to the growth of 6.0 percent. During the reference period, Agriculture activity recorded the largest contribution to growth of 16.8 percent, followed by Financial and Insurance (16.7 percent); Transport and storage (9.3 percent); Public administration & Defence (8.8 percent); Mining and Quarrying (7.5 percent); Trade and Repair (5.8 percent); and Education (5.6 percent).

2.0. Sectoral Performance

This section provides highlights on the economic activities carried out and their growth rates for the first quarter of 2026 compared with the similar period in 2025. Activities outlined in the sub-sections include crop production, livestock, forestry, and fishing. Other economic activities covered are mining and quarrying, manufacturing, electricity, water supply and construction. In addition, the section outlines other economic activities such as trade and repairs; transportation and storage; accommodation and food services; information and communication; financial and insurance services; real estate; professional, technical and scientific services; public administration and defense related services as well as education, human health, arts, entertainment and recreation; and other services.

2.1. Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing

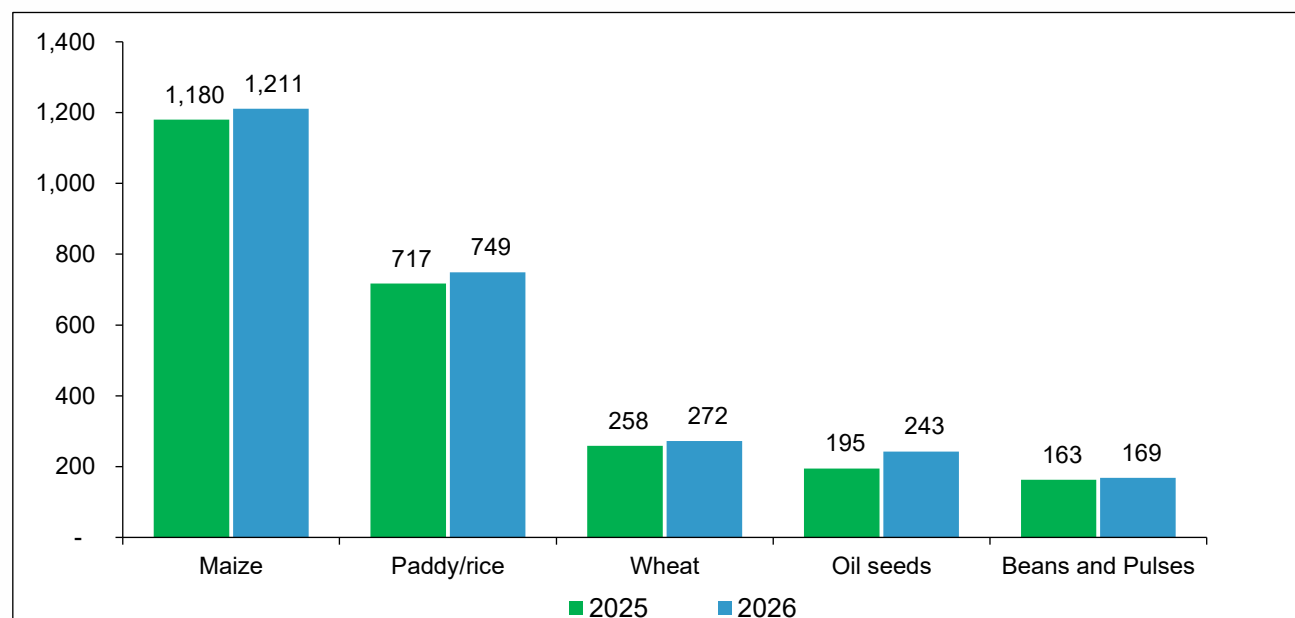
This sector includes the exploitation of vegetables and animal natural resources that comprise growing crops, raising and breeding animals, harvesting timber and other forest products plants, animals or animal products from a farm or their natural habitats. During the period between January and March 2026, the Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing grew by 4.6 percent, slightly lower than the 4.8 percent growth recorded during the same period in 2025.

2.1.1. Crops

Major crops covered include maize, paddy, sorghum/millet, other cereals, cassava, round potatoes, sweet potatoes, beans and other pulses, dried oilseeds, other vegetables, bananas, other fruits, cashew nuts, coffee, cotton, tea, tobacco, and other food and cash crops.

The crops sub-activity expanded by 3.0 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 3.5 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to increased crop production which benefited from the use of enhanced technology and quality agricultural inputs as well as the continued improvements in extension services.

Crops that significantly contributed to the growth of crop production during the first quarter of 2026 included maize, paddy, wheat, oil seed, and beans and pulses. During the reference period, maize production increased by 2.6 percent from 1.18 million tonnes in 2025 to 1.211 million tonnes in 2026, production of paddy/rice rose by 4.5 percent, from 717 thousand tonnes in 2025 to 749 thousand tonnes in 2026. Furthermore, wheat production increased by 5.4 percent from 258 thousand tonnes in 2025 to 272 thousand tonnes in 2026. Similarly, oil seeds production grew by 24.4 percent from 195 thousand tonnes in 2025 to 243 thousand tonnes in 2026, while beans and pulses production increased by 3.5 percent from 163 thousand tonnes to 169 thousand tonnes over the similar period.

2.1.2. Livestock

The activity covers livestock rearing, including improved and indigenous cattle; goats; sheep; donkeys; horses; pigs; rabbits; indigenous and commercial chicken; and other poultry.

During the period of January to March 2026, livestock recorded a growth rate of 5.2 percent compared with 4.9 percent observed during the corresponding period in 2025. The demand for livestock-based products as well as increased awareness of food nutrition, attributed to this growth.

2.1.3. Forestry and Logging

Forestry and Logging activity covers the production of timber, charcoal, fuel wood and logs, twigs, faggots (bundles of branches) and non-wood forest products. Forestry activity expanded by 6.8 percent in the first quarter of 2026 slightly lower than 7.6 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2025. This performance was largely attributed to the management of forest products and government interventions aimed at promoting sustainable harvesting and management of forest products.

2.1.4. Fishing

Fishing activity covers the harvest of fishery resources from marine or freshwater environments. Fishing activity recorded a growth rate of 6.1 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with 6.6 percent registered in the corresponding quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to Government efforts to ensure sustainable fish catch and fish products.

2.2. Mining and Quarrying

Mining and quarrying include the activities of extraction of minerals occurring naturally as solids (coal and ores), liquids (petroleum) or gases (natural gas). Extraction can be done from underground, on the surface mining or well operation. It also includes supplementary activities aimed at preparing the crude materials for marketing, for example, crushing and grinding; cleaning, drying, sorting, concentrating ores, liquefaction of natural gas and agglomeration of solid fuels. The units located nearby often accomplish the operations.

Mining and quarrying activity is divided into four industries, which are:

- i. Mining of coal, lignite, and extraction of peat.
- ii. Crude petroleum and natural gas.
- iii. Mining of metal ores; and
- iv. Other mining and quarrying

The activity grew by 7.6 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 15.5 percent recorded during the similar quarter in 2025. The changes were due to an increase in

production for some minerals, including Gold, Salt, Copper, Limestone, Stone and Bauxite (Table 2).

2.3. Manufacturing

Manufacturing activity involves the physical or chemical transformation of materials, substances, or components into final or semi-processed goods. The materials include products of agriculture, forestry, fishing, mining, and quarrying, as well as products of other manufacturing activities.

The activity recorded a growth rate of 3.0 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 0.7 percent registered in the corresponding quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to an increase in the production of manufactured goods.

2.4. Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air Conditioning Supply

The activity covers provision of electric power and natural gas, through permanent infrastructure (network) of lines, mains, and pipes. Specifically, the activity involves generation of electricity mainly from hydro, thermal and gas sources. The activity also includes the distribution of natural gas to consumers through pipeline networks. The primary sources of electricity generation data is the Tanzania Electric Supply Company Limited (TANESCO) while the main source of natural gas production data is the Tanzania Petroleum Development Corporation (TPDC).

The growth of electric and natural gas generation activities depends on the amount produced and distributed to customers. During the first quarter of 2026, electric generation and natural gas activities increased by 9.4 percent compared to 13.6 percent in the similar

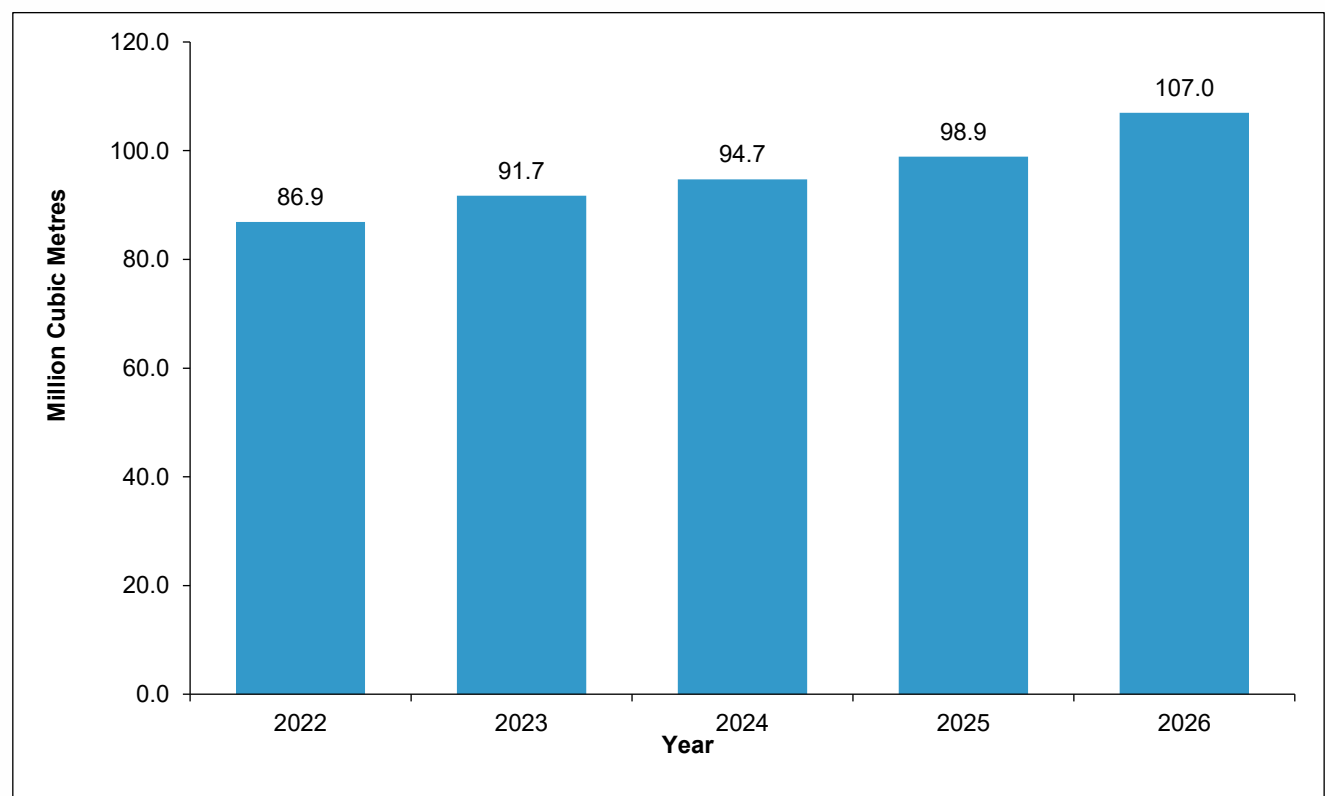
quarter in 2025. The growth was largely attributed to electricity generation from the Kishapu solar power generation plant.

2.5. Water Supply and Sewerage

The activity includes the collection and purification of water for water supply purposes, the desalting of sea water to produce water as the principal product of interest, and the collection of water directly from wells for use by water supply companies or used on one's own account, in agriculture or households. It also includes water distribution and the collection of wastewater activities.

The indicator for the growth of water supply activity is the quantity of water produced. During the reference period, the quantity of water produced increased to 107.0 million cubic meters from 98.9 million cubic meters recorded in the similar quarter in 2025. The activity grew at a rate of 7.5 percent in the first quarter of 2026 from 4.2 percent recorded in the corresponding quarter in 2025 (**Figure 7**).

2.6. Construction

This activity includes general construction and specialized construction activities for buildings and civil engineering works. It includes new work, repair, additions and

alterations, the erection of prefabricated buildings or structures on the site and construction of a temporary nature.

General construction deals with the construction of entire dwellings, office buildings, stores, and other public and utility buildings, farm buildings, etc. It also includes construction of civil engineering works such as motorways, streets, bridges, tunnels, railways, airfields, harbours and water projects, irrigation systems, sewerage systems, industrial facilities, pipelines, electric lines and sports facilities.

During the first quarter of 2026, construction activity recorded a growth rate of 1.8 percent compared with 0.9 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2025. Growth of construction activities is assessed based on domestically produced goods as well as imported materials used in construction activities. The growth was attributed to an increase in local production of construction materials, that includes cement and iron steels.

2.7. Wholesale and Retail Trade; Repair of Motor Vehicles, Motorcycles and Personal and Household Goods

The activity includes wholesale and retail sales (sale without transformation) of any type of goods as well as rendering services incidental to the sale of merchandise. It also includes repair of motor vehicles and the installation and repair of personal and household goods. The activity involves buying and selling of goods.

During the first quarter of 2026, the activity recorded a growth rate of 4.2 percent, slightly lower than the 4.7 percent recorded in the first quarter of 2025. The growth was due to an increase in goods traded for agriculture, livestock, fishing, mining and quarrying, manufactured and imported goods.

2.8. Transport and Storage

This activity includes the provision of passenger or freight transport, whether scheduled or not, by rail, pipeline, road, water, or air, and associated activities such as cargo handling, storage, etc. The activity also includes renting transport equipment with a driver or operator, and postal and courier activities. The activity expanded by 6.6 in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 8.3 percent registered in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to an increase in cargo tonnage and the number of passengers transported by road and Standard Gauge Railway transport services.

2.9. Accommodation and Food Services

This activity includes the provision of short-stay accommodation for visitors and other travelers, and the provision of complete meals and drinks fit for immediate consumption. The amount and type of supplementary services provided within this section can vary widely.

In the first quarter of 2026, accommodation and food services recorded a growth rate of 1.8 compared to 4.9 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to a decrease in the number of tourist arrivals and an increase in the number of beds occupied by domestic visitors. During the period under review, the number of tourist arrivals decreased by 1.1 percent to 520,891 from 526,856 tourists recorded in the same period in 2025.

2.10. Information and Communication

The activity covers publishing activities, motion picture, video, and television programming production, sound recording and music publishing, programming and broadcasting activities, e.g., radio and television broadcasting, telecommunications, computer programming, consultancy and related activities and information service activities, e.g., data processing and news agencies.

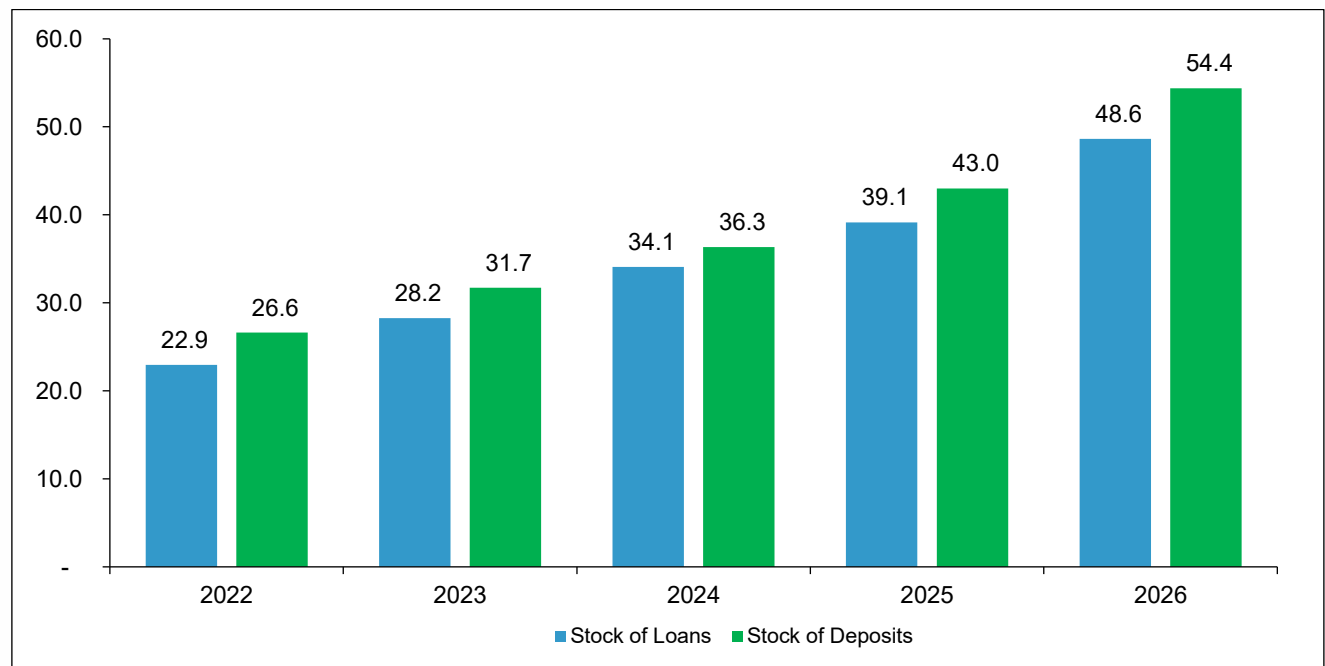
The activity recorded a growth rate of 10.1 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 8.9 percent in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth rate was attributed to an increase in the number of voice traffic per minute; the number of short message services traffic (SMS); the average number of mobile money subscribers; and the expansion of broadcasting and internet services in the country.

2.11. Financial and Insurance Services

The activity covers financial services, insurance and reinsurance, voluntary pension funding, and auxiliary services to financial services. It also includes the activities of holding assets, such as holding companies, trusts, funds, and similar financial entities. The activity recorded a growth rate of 20.5 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 13.3 percent in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to an increase of 26.5 percent in the level of deposits from TZS 43.0 trillion in the first quarter of 2025 to TZS 54.4 trillion in the similar period in 2026. Similarly, an increase of 24.3 percent in the level of lending from

TZS 39.1 trillion in the first quarter of 2025 to TZS 48.6 trillion in the corresponding period in 2026.

2.12. Real Estate

This activity includes selling or buying real estate, renting real estate and providing other real estate services such as appraising real estate. Activities in this industry may be carried out on own or leased property and may be done on a fee or contract basis. Also included is the building of structures, combined with maintaining ownership or leasing of such structures.

The activity increased by 9.7 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared to 8.5 percent observed in the corresponding quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to an increase in demand for accommodation services especially in urban areas.

2.13. Professional, Scientific and Technical Activities

This activity includes specialized professional, scientific, and technical activities. The activity requires a high degree of training, as well as making specialized knowledge and skills available to users. The activity includes legal and accounting activities; activities of head offices; management consultancy; architectural and engineering; technical testing

and analysis; scientific research and development; advertising and market research; other professional, scientific and technical activities; as well as veterinary activities.

The activity expanded by 3.9 percent in the first quarter of 2026 slightly lower than 10.9 percent growth registered in the corresponding period in 2025. The expansion was attributed to an increase in professional, scientific and technical services during the reference period.

2.14. Administrative and Support Services

The activity includes a variety of services that support general business operations. Administrative and support services involve rental and leasing; employment; travel agency; tour operator; reservation services and related activities; security and investigation; as well as services to buildings and landscape.

The activity recorded a growth of 4.6 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with 7.3 percent observed in the similar quarter in 2025. The expansion of travel agents and tour operators' services contributed to the growth of this economic activity.

2.15. Public Administration and Defense

The activity includes the enactment and judicial interpretation of laws, legislative activities, taxation, national defense, public order and safety, immigration services, foreign affairs, and the administration of government programmes. This activity also includes compulsory social security services.

The public administration and defense recorded a growth of 10.7 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with 10.0 percent observed in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to an increase in Government salaries, arrears and other government expenditure for maintaining peace and order, as well as the provision of social services.

2.16. Education

This activity includes education at any level or for any profession, oral or written, as well as by radio and television or other means of communication. It includes education by the different institutions in the regular school system at different levels, as well as adult education, literacy programs, etc. The activity includes public as well as private education.

Education activity increased to 11.3 percent in the first quarter of 2026, from 9.2 percent observed in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to an increase in the number of students enrolled at all levels of education in both public and private institutions

2.17. Human Health and Social Work

The activity includes the provision of health and social services. It includes a wide range of activities, including health care provided by trained medical professionals in hospitals and other facilities; other residential care activities that still involve a degree of health care; and social work activities without any involvement of health care professionals.

Human health and social work activity recorded a growth rate of 13.1 percent in the first quarter of 2026 up from, a growth rate of 8.1 percent registered in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth was attributed to a continued improvement in the provision of better health services at all levels.

2.18. Arts, Entertainment and Recreation

This activity includes a wide range of activities with the objective of meeting varied cultural, entertainment, and recreational interests of the public, including live performances, operation of museum sites, gambling, sports, and recreational activities.

In the first quarter of 2026, the activity recorded a growth rate of 8.3 percent, compared with a growth rate of 13.7 percent registered in the corresponding quarter in 2025. The growth of the activity was attributed to a continued increase in arts and entertainment activities.

2.19. Other Services Activities

This industry includes the activities of membership organizations; repair of computers and personal and household goods; and a variety of personal services not covered elsewhere in the classification. It also includes activities of households as employers.

The activity recorded a growth rate of 6.8 percent in the first quarter of 2026 compared with 5.6 percent in the similar quarter in 2025. The growth of the activity was attributed to an increase in urban population and personal service activities.

3.0. Conclusion

During the first quarter of 2026, GDP at constant 2019 prices increased to 6.0 percent from 4.3 percent recorded in the similar period in 2025. Economic activities that recorded significant growth included: Financial and Insurance (20.5 percent); Health (13.1 percent); Education (11.3 percent); Public administration & Defence (10.7 percent); Information and Communication (10.1 percent); Real estate (9.7 percent); and Electricity (9.4 percent).
