

2021-22 Demographic and Health Survey and Malaria Indicator Survey


The 2022 Tanzania Demographic and Health Survey and Malaria Indicator Survey (2022 TDHS-MIS), the 7th Demographic and Health Survey conducted in Tanzania since 1991-92 and the 5th Malaria Indicator Survey since 2007-08. The 2022 TDHS-MIS is designed to provide data for monitoring the population and health situation in Tanzania.

FERTILITY




Women in Tanzania have an average of **4.8** children.

Trends in Total Fertility Rate by Residence




22% of women age 15–19 have ever been pregnant.



CHILDHOOD MORTALITY


Trends in Childhood Mortality

Under-5 Mortality by Region




Figures in parentheses are based on 250–499 unweighted children.
